POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, January 30, 2012

0135 An officer observed a vehicle traveling south on Woodman Drive with an improper registration. The vehicle was stopped at 3401 Woodman and identified the driver. Dustin J. Perry W/M 22 was under several suspensions, so he was arrested and transported to the Kettering Jail. 2012-5428
