Traffic Stop Nets Drugs and Handgun

Kettering- Colin Ray Brinson, age twenty of Kettering; was arrested March 3 for Carrying a Concealed Weapon and several drug offenses.

Brinson was stopped at 9:45 p.m. for a traffic violation in the area of Wilmington Pike and Woodman Drive. Brinson and his adult male passenger both admitted to having marijuana in their possession after the officer and K9 "Bandit" detected an odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle.

A loaded handgun was located underneath the driver's seat. A safe in the trunk of the vehicle contained Methamphetamine, Vicodin and a digital scale.

The passenger of the vehicle was issued a summons for Drug Possession and released. Brinson was arrested and booked into the Kettering Jail with no bond. The Montgomery County Prosecutor's Office will review the case for formal charges.
