Kettering Police Interrupt Breaking and Entering

Kettering- Darren L. Evers, age 36 of Dayton was taken into custody by Kettering Police detectives today at approximately 12:30 p.m. for Attempted Breaking and Entering and Obstruction of Official Business. Detectives were led to an apartment building on Grove Avenue in Dayton after they received tips about Evers location.

Today at approximately 1:25 a.m., a Kettering officer on patrol observed an individual running from Sima, a Korean and Japanese restaurant located at 1771 Woodman Drive. The hooded subject was carrying a crowbar. Officers found fresh damage to the front and rear doors of the business. A 1995 Hyundai Elantra was in the parking lot of the restaurant at the time of the incident. Within minutes of the hooded subject running from the officer, the vehicle was reported stolen to Dayton Police.

Solid investigative work led detectives to arrest Evers on suspicion of the Breaking and Entering offense. Detectives will examine other recent cases of Breaking and Entering to determine if Evers is responsible for them as well.
