POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, December 31, 2007

1103 Ptl Pedro responded to the CVS at 1410 E. Dorothy Lane on report of a subject attempting to pass a forged prescription. Upon arrival Ptl. Pedro located the subject still inside the store. Investigation revealed that the subject did attempt to pass a forged prescription. Arrested for Deception to Obtain Drugs and Illegal Processing was **Jamie L. Blevins W/F/19** of 1537 Cardington St. Kettering. The suspect was conveyed to KPD Jail w/o incident.
