POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, January 3, 2011

1217 An officer was dispatched to the BP Station on Indian Ripple Road to meet a Greene County Sheriff's Deputy for a prisoner exchange. After verifying the KMC warrant for FTC, he took custody of one Ladonna L. Anderson and transported her to KPD Jail. 10-54779

2042 An officer made a traffic stop at Valley Forge and Montgomery Sq. The driver's status revealed that he was under suspension. Kristopher Allen, b/m, 26; was placed under arrest and transported to KPD Jail for booking. 11-412

2110 An officer was sent to MCSO jail for a subject wanted on a KMC bench warrant. Once there, she took custody of one Derek Sturgill. Sturgill was transported to KPD Jail for booking. 11-52935
