POLICE BLOTTER

Wednesday, January 09, 2008

0315 Ptl. Sanders was dispatched to the Kmart on Indian Ripple Rd to meet with a Beavercreek officer on a warrant service. When Ptl. Sanders arrived he took custody of a Nola C Lewchenko W/F/20 for FTC on an original charge of Weaving. Lwechenko was transported to KPD Jail for processing without incident.

Thursday, January 10, 2008

2345 Ptl. Mason was on patrol in the area of Kroger, 2115 E. Dorothy Ln, when he observed Willie M. Haygood, b/m/65, urinating on a telephone pole. Ptl. Mason located drug paraphernalia, metal pipe with burnt residue, on Haygood. Haygood also had an active warrant for his arrest from Dayton PD. Haygood was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail without incident.

0027 Ptl. Marcum was dispatched to 3221 Ackerman on the report of a menacing. Upon his arrival, he found that **Alexander B. Sigmund, w/m23**, had threatened to kill Jessica George. The officer then checked the passengers and found a warrant on **Steven F. Cooley W/M/28** from our court. The subject was brought to KPD for processing.

1715 Off. J. Kelch was dispatched to 2580 N. Aragon Av. to meet with a Beavercreek officer ref. a subject who had a Kettering warrant. Upon her arrival she took KENNETH B. SCHWARTZ, W/M/27 into custody and transported him to the Kettering Jail where he was served.

Saturday, January 12, 2008

0025 Crews responded to Wize Guyz on report of a disturbance in the lot. Upon arrival, the officers found that **Nicholas N. Rohrback W/M/27** and **Shawn L. Oakes W/M/32** were fighting in the lot. During the fight, **Matthew C. Oakes W/M/22** became a participant by trying to get Rohrback off his brother (Shawn). In the course of the fight, Shawn Oakes suffered a severe break to his left leg (compound fracture) and was removed to the hospital for treatment. Nicholas was observed by officers trying to dispose of some white pills by throwing them under a parked car. He was charged with possession of drugs. Nicholas and Shawn were cited for disorderly conduct for their role in the fight. Matthew was found to have a warrant for his arrest and he was brought to KPD for processing.

Saturday, January 12, 2008

0225 Ptl. M. Woolf observed a vehicle running in the parking lot of the Stroop-Mar Plaza. This vehicle had been observed in the same location over an hour earlier by the officer and had not moved. Upon approaching the vehicle, the officer observed a male lying across the front seat apparently passed out. The officer was finally able to wake up the male identified as **Robert C. Fisher Jr. W/M/22**. The subject was asked to step from the car and then refused to submit to any SFSTs. The subject was very unsteady on his feet and became verbally abusive. The subject was brought to KPD for processing. He refused to submit to Datamaster testing.

0236 Ptls. Geckler and Price were dispatched to Research and Spaulding on report a subject passed out in his car in the intersection. Upon arrival, the officers found **Paul W Yahle W/M/49** passed out with his foot on the brake and the car running. The officers were able to shut the car off and remove the keys without the subject waking up. The subject was awakened and asked to perform the SFSTs. The subject failed the tests and was brought to KPD for processing. The subject tested .210 BAC on the Datamaster.

Ptl Driscoll was dispatched to Kettering Hospital on a Deception to Obtain Drugs. On arrival spoke to Barb Lauderbach, she remembers a subject being treated, had used a different name in Nov to obtain drugs. Ptl Driscoll made contact with the subject and discovered he has used 14 different names to obtain drugs over the last year. Kelly Sturgill was arrested and transported to KPD jail. Detectives notified.

He also denied going through vehicles.
