POLICE BLOTTER

Tuesday, January 15, 2008

2340 Ptls. Walker, Tischler, and Lambert went to 1625 Stroop, and arrested **Phillip A. Madaffer, W/M/46**, on a Beaver Creek PD warrant. Madaffer was transported to the KPD Jail, where he was held for BPD.

Wednesday, January 16, 2008

0010 Ptl. Meno had stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation at Wilmington at Woodman, and ran a computer check on the passenger, **Habiba Z. Ramey, B/F/32**, and found that there was an active warrant for her arrest from Dayton PD. Ramey was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail without incident.

0200 Ptl. Meno was on patrol in the area of E. Stroop/Pobst, when he clocked a vehicle 52/35. The vehicle was also failing to maintain a continuous lane of travel. A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver, **Brian O. Breland, B/M/24**, was found to be OVI after failing the SFST's. Breland was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail, where she tested .163 BAC.

0203 Ptl. Walker was on patrol in the area of Patterson/Aragon, when he observed a vehicle failing to maintain a continuous lane of travel. The vehicle was also moving 50/35. A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver, **Amber N. Kramer, W/F/25**, was found to be OVI after failing the SFST's. Kramer was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail, where she refused any further testing. Kramer admitted that she was under the influence of drugs, mixed with alcohol. Kramer was also charged with DUS.

Wednesday, January 16, 2008

0245 Ptl. B. Lambert was waiting for a tow truck from Ptl. Meno's arrest at E Stroop and Pobst when he observed a vehicle pass him at 57mph in the 35mph zone. The vehicle was stopped and the driver, **Robert F. Pina B/M/40**, was found to have been drinking. After performing field sobriety tests, Pina was arrested for OVI and transported to KPD Jail for processing. Once at the jail, Pina tested a .227 on the Datamaster.

0318 Ptl. Marcum, Ptl Warner and Sgt. Domsitz were dispatched to 4975 Croftshire, on the report of a female, Jena Dyke, locked inside a bedroom, hiding from her boyfriend, **Thad Joshua Daubenmire, W/M/20**, who had just beat her up. As the crews arrived, they were met by Daubenmire, and his mother, Jennifer Drennen at the door. Daubenmire found that he was being arrested on an active warrant, and tried to pass a 9mm handgun off to his mother to hide, which she did momentarily. Daubenmire was arrested for CCW, Assault, and the warrants. Dyke had minor injuries, but refused medical care. The weapon was immediately taken from Drennen. Daubenmire was transported to the KPD Jail. Felony charges are being sought.

1705 Off. J. Kelch was on Glenheath when she observed a Jeep E/B approaching E. Stroop Rd. and the vehicle windows had a very dark tint. The officer initiated a traffic stop. The driver, **LUIS RAUL PEREZ HERNANDEZ, H/M/27** stated that he did not have a drivers license. He stated that all he had was a passport and that he bought the Jeep and had it registered to him but did not get a license. Subject was arrested for no OL.

1830 Off. J. Kelch, K. McGuire and Capt. M. Kemper were dispatched to 3321 E. Stroop Rd. on an attempt warrant service. Upon their arrival they found the suspect walking up the staircase toward his apartment. **NATHANIEL JACOB DEPEW, W/M/20** was arrested and transported to the Kettering Jail where he was served.

Upon arrival the officer's spotted the female suspect at the bus stop near the Speedway. She was confronted and she told the officer's that she put the cat food back. It was learned that she had stolen a box of Scotch Brite pads, the RP from the store was brought to the scene and identified both the merchandise and the suspect. **JOYCE E. FURL, W/F/50** was arrested and transported to the Kettering jail.

Thursday, January 17, 2008

2241 Ptl. Tischler stopped a motorist on Purdue at Dorothy for an illegal lane change. While speaking with the driver he noted that he had been drinking. After failing SFST **Justin Henderson w/m 18** was arrested for OVI and transported to KPD Jail where he refused datamaster. Three passengers in the car, **Travis Baker w/m 17, Jacob Daubenmire w/m 17 and Carla McCarthy w/f 17** were all charged with underage alcohol offenses.

0045hrs. Ptl. Meno was on patrol in the area of Woodman/E. Dorothy, when he clocked a vehicle moving 47/35. A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver, **Kristy K. Ribbink, w/f/46**, was found to be DUS. Ribbink was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail without incident.

0106 Sgt. Karolyi stopped a vehicle for driving on the wrong side of the road on Wilmington at Valleywood Drive. The driver was found to have been drinking. After failing SFST, **Joshua Tokarz w/m 22** was arrested for OVI and transported to KPD Jail where he tested .180 on the Datamaster.

Upon their arrival they found a female lying unconscious on the couch in the apartment. KFD was called to the scene because the female was unresponsive. It was also learned that the female, **ALECIA M. FRISCH, W/F/49** had a warrant on her for Contempt of Court, original charge, Trespassing. The subject was removed to the hospital and she was served both the warrant and summons to appear in court.

1819 Ptl. C. Price stopped Christopher E. Campbell (B/M/39) on Montgomery Square and Whipp Rd. because he knew he was driving under suspension. Upon making the stop he verified that Campbell was under suspension and he had 15 active suspensions for failure to reinstate. He was arrested and brought to KPD Jail without incident.

2334 Ptl. M. Woolf was dispatched to Kettering Hospital on report of a possible shooting. When he arrived he met with hospital personnel who advised, **Alecia M. Frisch W/F/49**, who had been brought in earlier by KFD Medics from 3217 Wilmington PK as being intoxicated and unresponsive actually had a bullet lodged in the base of her skull. No entrance wound could be located at this time and it was unclear if this was a new injury or an old one. Detectives were called and the investigation is ongoing.

Friday, January 18, 2008

0200 Ptl. G. Schomburg was dispatched to the area of Woodman Dr and Linden Ave to meet with Riverside PD on a warrant detail. When he arrived he took custody of **Marco M. Danner B/M/18** for an active warrant. The warrant was for FTC on a traffic citation. Danner was transported to KPD Jail for processing without incident.

0235 Ptl. W. Aldrich was dispatched to the K-Mart on Indian Ripple Rd to meet with Beavercreek PD on a warrant detail. When he arrived he took custody of **Jason J. Haywood W/M/24** for an active warrant. The warrant was for FTA/FTC on an original charge of Theft. Haywood was transported to KPD Jail for processing. Once at KPD Jail, Haywood proceeded to tear apart his cell pillow. Haywood was then charged with Damaging Jail Property.

0304 Ptl. Geckler observed a car at Wilmington and Dorothy operating in an erratic manner. Upon stopping the car, he found that the driver-**Christopher J. Rau W/M/37** had been drinking. The subject was very uncooperative and refused to submit to any SFSTs or HGN evaluation. The subject claimed all the tests were subjective and he would not participate. The subject was taken into custody and brought to KPD. The subject refused to submit to Datamaster testing. This subject has a prior conviction and refusal through our court.

0930 Ptl. Bodner traveled to the Miami Co. Jail on a warrant detail. Upon arrival he took custody of **Tony M. Clark wm/47**, wanted on our active warrant for PI, and transported him to the jail where he was served.

1829 Ptl. K. McGuire was dispatched to Sugarcreek Township PD to pick up Candace K. Nichols (W/F/37) who was being held on our FTC/FTA warrant for a traffic offense. She was brought to KPD Jail without incident.

2025 Ptl. J. Kelch and Ptl. B. Lambert were dispatched to 4306 Meadowcroft to pick up Jamie D. Welborn (W/M/21) who was wanted on a warrant from Centerville. He was transported to KPD Jail without incident

Saturday, January 19, 2008

The right front tire had been shredded and the rim was now crushed to the disc brake resulting in metal to road contact. The officer found that the driver- **Wilbur L. Asberry W/M/75** was extremely intoxicated. The subject did not even realize that the tire was gone and he was driving on the rim. The subject failed the SFSTs and was brought to KPD for processing. The subject tested .190 on the Datamaster.

0140 Ptl. Geckler stopped a car on Aerial Ave. at Dorothy Ln. for a red light violation and weaving. Upon contacting the driver- **Khristina R. Huist W/F/29** the officer found that she had been drinking. The subject failed the SFSTs and was brought to KPD for processing. The subject refused the Datamaster test once at KPD. This subject also had 2 prior OVIs on her record.

0223 Ptl. Aldrich stopped a car on Stroop Rd. at Wagner for a weaving violation. Upon contacting the driver- **Patrick S. McCoy W/M/39** the officer discovered that the subject had been drinking. The subject failed the SFSTs and was brought to KPD for processing. The subject refused to submit to Datamaster testing.

Fitts B/M/18**, was also found to have been drinking and after having been warned to be quiet continued to yell obscenities. Fitts was then arrested by Ptl. A. Walker Underage Consumption.

0245 Ptl. V. Mason was dispatched to 2115 E Whipp Rd Apt L on report of a burglary. When he arrived he met with the female resident who advised the father of her child, **Billy W. Betts W/M/23**, had entered her apartment by removing the sliding glass door to her apartment. Betts then assaulted the resident and fled the scene when she called 911. A teletype was sent and Betts was located at his residence in Miamisburg. Betts was arrested by Ptl. Mason for Domestic Violence and Burglary and transported to KPD Jail for processing.

1930 Crews were sent to Twilight Hill on a report of a family trouble. Female caller sated that her husband pointed a gun at her and she ran out of the house and to a neighbors to place the call. Crews responded to scene and set up a perimeter. Contact was made with the complainant who advised that her husband did not point the gun at her or threaten her, but just had it out in his hand during their argument. She also advised he had several long guns and pistols in the residence. Phone contact was made with the husband who was reluctant to come out at first but with Ptl. Kisaberth's persuasion complied and exited the house where he was met by officers. After speaking with the wife in detail it was determined no crime was committed. The husband, **David Buehler** offered up the weapons in good faith for KPD to hold for safe keeping. Officers took over 12 pistols/assault rifles and shotguns out of the house including ones found in the bathroom, under couch cushions and hidden inside books with the pages cut out.

2200 Ptl. Drayton met with CPD on a warrant service. **Jeffery Clark w/m 36** was taken into custody on our warrant and transported to KPD Jail without incident.
