POLICE BLOTTER

Monday January 28, 2008

1642 Ptl. D. Gaudette located a subject at 1950 E. Stroop wanted for an active warrant from Bellbrook PD. During the arrest the subject was found in possession of several Sch II, III, and IV prescription drugs. **Jeffery D. Tamme (W/M 25)** was arrested on the warrant and charge with Misdemeanor and Felony Drug Possession. Tamme was transported to KPD jail without incident.

1700 Ptl. M. Steffano was dispatched to the Dayton Heart Hospital to serve a summons on **Patrick E. McCullough (W/M/59)**. The original charge was for theft and this was followed with a failure to appear.

2001 Off. G. Stout stopped the vehicle on Brainard @ Whipp Rd. for no license plate light and turn signal violation. He approached vehicle and smelled a strong odor of marijuana. Off. C. Price and Bandit arrived on scene. Bandit hit on the vehicle and a search of the vehicle revealed bagged crack, bagged cocaine and pills. Also found was bagged marijuana, all of which was concealed in the shoe of the driver and of the passenger. **GRIER, STEPHONE A., B/M/28** arrested for the felony drug possession. **STARGELL, DARNELL J. Saturday, February 02, 2008

0900 Ptl. D. Warren went to the MCSO jail on a warrant detail. Upon arrival he took custody of **Jeffery Murdock bm/20**, wanted on our active warrant for DUS, and transported him to the jail where he was served.

1014 Ptl. Young responded to Dot's market on a theft complaint. Investigation revealed that **Ricky B. Patterson wm/51** had concealed several items on his person, valued at \$27.06, and left the store without paying for them. Patterson was arrested and transported to the jail.

1130 Ptl. G. Geisel was dispatched to KMH on report of a wanted subject who was getting ready to leave. Upon arrival he located and arrested **Sarah Anne Neef wf/29**, who had several active warrants from other jurisdictions.

1604 Ptl. Gibson was sent to MCSO Jail on a warrant service. Upon arrival she took custody of a **Tony J. Knowles w/m 43** wanted on our warrant.

Saturday, February 02, 2008

2000 Crews were sent to KMH ref. a subject fighting with security in the parking lot. When crews arrived they found the subject in a vehicle which did not belong to him. He was transported to KMH by W. Carrollton PD and dropped off. The subject was intoxicated and upset that he wasn't being attended to at the hospital so he decided to leave. Gibson arrived on scene first and used her taser gaining compliance from the subject who had assaulted the security staff. Crews remained on scene until the doctors medicated the subject who eventually calmed down and was restrained to his bed.

2300 Ptl. Tischler was dispatched to 2262 Patterson Blvd on a report of a family trouble. While doing a warrant check on the involved party he was advised that a **Kneshia N. Mills B/F 21** was wanted on two outside warrants. After confirmation Mills was taken into custody.

Sunday, February 03, 2008

0130 Sgt. Karolyi stopped a vehicle on Shroyer at Issac Prugh after first observing the vehicle to be stuck up on a concrete Island in the Town and Country Plaza. The vehicle then continued north on Shroyer driving left of center and then running the red traffic signal at Shroyer and Lincoln Park. The

Griffiths, w/m/37**, was found to be OVI after failing the SFST's. As Ptl. Kelch was speaking with Griffiths, she observed a baggie of what she believed to be cocaine next to him. Griffiths admitted that he had just purchased the cocaine from someone at The Greene. Griffiths was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail where he refused the BAC. Griffiths was charged with OVI, No OL, and Possession of Cocaine.

0138 Ptl. Sanders was on patrol in the area of Woodman/Dorothy, when he observed a truck make an improper turn, began driving erratically, and then pulled into the exit of Kroger. A traffic stop was initiated. The driver, **Carly Marie Watkins, w/f/14**, was found to not have an OL. Watkins' mother, **Sheilah L. Watkins, w/f/43**, had given Carly permission to drive Sheilah's boyfriend, **Greg F. Hester, w/m/43**, to Taco Bell because they were hungry. Carly was cited for No OL and a Lanes Violation. Sheilah was cited for Wrongful Entrustment. This case is also being reviewed by the law department for Child Endangering charges against Sheilah. Hester was also cited for Wrongful Entrustment.

Eck was arrested, and at that time was found to have marijuana on his person. Eck was transported to the KPD Jail for the warrant, and issued summons for the marijuana.

0135 Ptl. Warner was on patrol in the area of Bigger/Hewitt, when she observed a vehicle commit a stop sign violation. A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver, **Scott J. Niederstadt, w/m/30**, was found to be DUS. Niederstadt was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail without incident.
