## **POLICE BLOTTER**

Tuesday February 05, 2008

2132 Officer K. McGuire was sent to Meijer, 4075 Wilmington, for an adult shoplifter in custody. Store security detained a subject after she concealed \$163.72 of merchandise and then attempted to leave the store without paying for it. **Deborah J. Staley (W/F 37)** was arrested for theft and transported to KPD jail for processing.

2315 Ptl. Soto was dispatched to the Hamilton County SO to pick up **Eartha L. Smith, b/f/50**, who had been detained on a KPD warrant. Smith was transported to the KPD Jail without incident.

Wednesday, February 06, 2008

0310 Ptl. Bower was on patrol in the area of Dorothy/Purdue, when he observed a vehicle with no license plate light and failing to maintain a continuous lane of travel. A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver, **Jeremie C. Morris, w/m/27**, was found to be OVI after failing the SFST's. Morris was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail, where he refused any further tests.

1555 Officer K. Tischler stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation in the 3000 block of Woodman Dr. The driver had no driving privileges due to an FRA suspension. **Lonnie R. Hazlip (W/M 33)** was arrested for DUS and transported to KPD jail.

purses/wallets taken. A white male suspect was seen at the thefts on Woodman.

## Wednesday, February 06, 2008

1748 Crews responded to an Attempted Aggravated Robbery at the Ameristop, 1920 E. Whipp Rd. A black male subject showed the victim a handgun and demanded his money. The suspect left the area in a green vehicle without any money from the victim. A partial registration was obtained and is being followed up on.

1842 Crews responded to 1640 Phoenix on subjects entering a house under construction. Officer W. Miller located 2 juveniles and learned they cut the Tyvex sheeting and entered the house. A 15 year old male and 14 year old female were arrested for Criminal Trespassing and Criminal Damaging and turned over to their parents.

1920 Officer C. Price was sent to 5424 Bunkerhill on a disturbance. The male resident assaulted the female resident and mother of his child. **Lucas R. Pelhan (W/M 23)** was arrested for Domestic Violence and transported to KPD jail for processing.

2011 Meijer, 4075 Wilmington, attempted to apprehend a male shoplifter after he left the store without paying for concealed merchandise. The suspect fled on foot and was located by Sgt. M. Gabrielson and Officer R. Roberts. The suspect was taken back to Meijer where he was ID by security. **Willie M. Haygood Jr (B/M 65)** was arrested for Theft of over \$300 of merchandise. Haygood was transported to KPD jail without incident.

2100 Officer C. Price located an intoxicated female walking on Marshall at Rose Bower. Officer M. Burke responded and arrested **Keitha Pugh (W/F 43)** for Disorderly Conduct – Public Intoxication after he determined she was too intoxicated to care for herself. Pugh was transported to KPD jail for processing.

Thursday, February 07, 2008

The victim stated he had never seen the suspect before and has no idea what he is upset about. The suspect was taken into custody and brought to KPD for processing.

The subject then kept coming out of the bedroom yelling about how this wasn't fair. He continued to be disruptive and abusive. He was taken into custody for disorderly conduct and brought to KPD for processing.
