POLICE BLOTTER

Tuesday, February 26, 2008

Officer Rustad responded to the Kettering Municipal Court on report of a Criminal Mischief. Investigation revealed that a subject being detained in the holding cell at the Municipal Court had masturbated and defecated in the cell and smeared his body fluids all over inside of the cell. The suspect was removed to KPD Jail where he continued this conduct in the City Jail isolation cell. The suspect was subsequently removed to KHM and involuntarily admitted to KMH for a mental examination. The suspect, **Jay W. Martin, W/M/26** of 391 Whittington Dr., Centerville, OH, was charged with Criminal Mischief.

2100 Ptl. J. Kelch and Ptl. C. Price went to 4793 Bigger Rd. on a warrant service. While there they arrested Barry M O'Neal (W/M/39) who was wanted on our disorderly conduct warrant. He was brought to KPD Jail without incident.

2218 Ptl. Kelch was sent to 1220 E. Dorothy Ln. on a report of an abduction. The boyfriend at that location called KPD and advised he just received a text message from his girlfriend a Theresa Loyd that read "help me they got me don't know who they r has gun " then another that read "cant phone about to die and they don't know on 75" and a final that read "3 guys in mask don't understand". The phone was pinged and would only give an area that would be south of 1400 Wilmington Pike. Crews attempted to locate Loyds car but were unsuccessful. Around 0130 the boyfriend contacted KPD and advised Loyd arrived back home. Det. MArkowski who had been called in interviewed Loyd who admitted the whole abduction was a lie.

Wednesday, February 27, 2008

1420 Officer Young & Abrams responded to the area of 1431 Central Park on a tip that a wanted subject was located there. Investigation revealed the subject was at that location. Arrested was **Jessica N. Young, W/F/20** of 1431 Central Park. The subject was wanted on two warrants, Passing Bad Checks, and Assault. The suspect was conveyed to KPD Jail w/o incident.

After his identity was learned and he was found to be under suspension, **Paul F. Milliner b/m 29** was arrested for DUS and for providing false info .

A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver, **Justin D Achor, w/m/21**, was found to be OVI after failing the SFST's. Achor was arrested, and transported to the KDP Jail, where he tested .103 BAC.
