POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, March 16, 2009

1600 Ptl. Soto checked the license plate of a vehicle he observed on Horlacher Drive. Upon doing so, he found that the registered owner was wanted on a Kettering FTC warrant. The officer temporarily lost sight of the vehicle but checked the area of Eastgate since that was the street where the registered owner resided. The officer located the vehicle as it quickly pulled into the driveway of 4627 Eastgate. Ptl. Soto made contact with the driver and confirmed the active Kettering Warrant. Johnny T. Smith, w/m/44, was placed under arrest without incident and transported to KPD jail. 08-57513

Hellmund's mother allowed a search but the bag was not where Hellmund said it was. Bandit was brought in and located several items of paraphernalia in Justin's bedroom along with two growing marijuana plants. After attempts to locate the ounce bought were unsuccessful, the mother broke down and told Sgt. Karolyi she took the dope and hid it at her daughters on Chippendale. Sgt. Karolyi escorted her to the Chippendale address and recovered the evidence. Justin Hellmund w/m 17; was summoned for Drug possession/ drug paraphernalia / and for cultivating. Nick Flowers w/m 20; was arrested for Drug Trafficking / Possession of Drugs / Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. 2009-13083

The detective section was notified and the coroner's office responded to conduct their investigation.
