Wednesday, April 02, 2008

0055 Ptl. R. Meno was in the parking lot of Sports-N-Spirits, 1725 Woodman Dr, when he observed a suspicious vehicle occupied by three subjects in the parking lot. During a routine check of the subjects one of them was found to be on the Dayton Capias Sheet. The warrant on **Christopher L. Bowman, W/M/27** for FTA on original charge of NO OL was confirmed. Bowman was arrested and transported to KPD Jail for processing without incident. **2008-16619**

0123 Ptl. K. Tischler stopped a suspicious truck he observed pulling out from behind the We Care Arts lot, 3035 Wilmington Pk. Ptl.
