## POLICE BLOTTER

Tuesday, April 15, 2008

1541 Ptl. J. Soto observed a vehicle weaving in the area of Whipp Rd. Upon stopping the vehicle he discovered that the driver had been drinking. He arrested Tamela L. Walker (W/F/38) for OVI and charged her with OVI refusal, improper turn, failure to maintain continuous lane. She was brought to KPD Jail without incident.

2300 Off. L. Warren was on patrol traveling S/B Wilmington Pk. when he observed a grey Jeep turn onto S/B Wilmington Pk. from Beaver creek Ln. in front of him. He noticed that the driver was having a difficult time keeping the vehicle within the lane of travel. He then observed the vehicle strike the curb and then move to the left across the lines dividing the lanes. The vehicle was stopped at Jaybee Ct. and the driver was questioned. The victim stated the suspect claimed to have gotten rid of the knife but then displayed a dark object and claimed it was a 9mm. The area was searched but no gun or knife found. The subject was too intoxicated to care for himself and reported he was homeless. **William C. Beck took exception to his arrest and called Officer Charles a "punk" and told him to "watch his back".
