POLICE BLOTTER

Tuesday April 22, 2008

1705 Officer M. Burke was sent to the area of 949 Lincoln Park on a dog at large. The loose Husky mix was aggressive to subjects in the area. Officer Burke located the owner **Ronald G. Castle (W/M 43)** and cited him for Dog At Large **08-20361**.

1838 Officer Steffano met with Dayton PD who had detained a subject on an active KPD warrant. Officer Steffano confirmed the warrant and took custody of the subject. **Wendell S. Weber (W/M 53)** was arrested on the warrant, original charge OVI **08-1788**, and transported to KPD jail for processing.

Barr was cited for the refusal due to a prior OVI conviction. Barr was later charged with possession of Xanax a Schedule IV narcotic after a prescription bottle belonging to another person was found hidden in her bar by MCSO jail personnel. The passenger, **Kathleen Y. Gates W/F/36**, who originally flagged down Ptl. Mason, did not appear to have been kidnapped, but in fact woke up confused after possibly taking too much medication. Gates was unable to find someone to come and get her so she was arrested for Disorderly Conduct/PI. Another passenger, **Jeremy D. Bartee W/M/20**, was also intoxicated and in fact his face and body had been painted blue by his friends after passing out earlier in the evening. Bartee, along with **Joshua M. Rochelle B/M/21** were found to be too intoxicated to care for themselves and were also arrested for Disorderly Conduct/PI. All were transported to KPD Jail for processing. **2008-21022**

Saturday, April 26, 2008

0112 Ptl. W. Aldrich stopped a vehicle at Valleywood and E Dorothy for turning left in front of him nearly causing an accident. The driver, **Kathleen A. Waker W/F/47**, was found to be highly intoxicated. After failing field sobriety tests, Waker was arrested for OVI. Waker later refused the Datamaster and was cited for the refusal due to her having prior OVI convictions. The passenger in Waker's vehicle, **Troy C. KPD assisted Dayton PD at 2262 E. Bataan, who were out with a vehicle that had fled from them in Dayton. Further checking showed the car to be similar and with the same front plate, but missing the rear plate and not the same model of vehicle. Checking the area Ptl. Gibson located the actual suspect vehicle parked at 1960 E. Bataan and got information from some witness as to where the occupant had gone. Along with Ptl. Drayton and Dayton crews, a house was checked but the suspects were not there. Further information led Ptl. Gibson to 1901 Roop where she observed the suspects leaving there as passengers in another vehicle. The vehicle was stopped and while waiting for back-up, the suspects fled on foot. Ptl. Gibson gave chase soon to be assisted by Ptl. Drayton and DPD officers. Ptl. Gibson advised the one suspect was east on Research Blvd. Sgt. Karolyi observed this subject and gave a short chase with the patrol car and then on foot across the cornfield and into the back yards on Farmside Dr. While cutting through the yards, Sgt. Karolyi observed the suspect throwing evidence into the bushes. Sgt. Karolyi was able to close the distance to within 21 feet and deployed the Taser which ended the chase.
