POLICE BLOTTER

Tuesday, April 29, 2008

0606 Several crews were dispatched to 1500 Moler Drive re: Rape with the suspect still on the scene. On arrival spoke to the victim Amanda Heckman, she stated that an ex-boyfriend, **John A. Knabe w/m, 36**, had forced himself on her. She was transported to KMC for treatment. The suspect was located and statements obtained. The incident is under investigation.

Wednesday April 30, 2008

0030 Ptl. Walker was on patrol in the area of Woodman/Dorothy, when he observed a vehicle moving 55/35. A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver, **Dale J. Baxter, w/m/42**, was found to be OVI after failing the SFST's. Baxter was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail, where he tested .142 BAC.
