POLICE BLOTTER

Tuesday May 06, 2008

1847 Officer K. McGuire was sent to 2159 Rahn Rd on a suspicious vehicle. He found the vehicle with its driver passed out behind the wheel. Further investigation showed that the driver had been drinking, ran out of gas, and passed out while waiting for friends to assist him. **Robert C. Markstrom (W/M 33)** was unable to care for himself and was arrested for Disorderly Conduct – Public Intoxication, 08-22871.

2001 Officer C. Price stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation at Montgomery Square and Valleygreen. The driver had an active warrant for his arrest from MCSO. **Roshawn J.
