POLICE BLOTTER

Tuesday May 13, 2008

0840 Ptl. Driscoll responded to 2088 Maplecrest on report of a suspicious person possibly living out of a van. Ptl. Driscoll located the subject asleep in his van at that location. Wednesday, May 14, 2008

0200 Ptl. Aldrich stopped a car for weaving on Wilmington Pk. in the 4100 block. Upon stopping the car, the officer discovered that the driver- **James R. Shay W/M/27** had been drinking. Suspect was W/B on Dorothy @ Powhattan when he struck three cars which were also W/B and then went left of center and struck another vehicle which was E/B. Three subjects were removed to Kettering Hospital, unknown injuries at this time. Suspect was under suspension for prior OVI's.
