Tuesday, May 20, 2008

0745 Ptl Tobias, Rustad were notified of an active warrant for William Wikie by Ptl Marcum. The officers responded to 1840 Culver and arrested the subject. He was transported to KPD jail. Charges DUS, Failure to Restate License, Possession of Criminal Tools, Criminal Damage.

1601 Officer K. McGuire responded to 3801 Traine Dr. on a theft complaint. Upon his arrival he found Dustin R. Wagers (W/M/22) who had a warrant for his arrest for theft of checks. He was arrested and brought to KPD Jail without incident.
