POLICE BLOTTER

Tuesday, May 22, 2007

1612 Ptl. Stout traveled past 2648 Parklawn #2 and recognized the female resident, **Melissa A. Bolden (W/F 26)**. Ptl. Stout knew Bolden had an active warrant (FTC Traffic) through Sugarcreek Twp. Bolden was arrested without incident.

2042 Crews were sent to 1896 Chimney Lane #2B on a report of the resident, **John Sullivan (W/M 35)**, throwing items out of his apartment and acting disorderly. While the door was open, a neighbor walked past and saw her stolen license plate hanging on Sullivan's wall. Sullivan was ordered out of the apartment but shut himself in a bedroom. Sullivan continued to refuse orders and the taser was deployed to affect the arrest after he broke through the bedroom door. Detectives were notified and will follow up on felony charges.

2220 Ptl. Burke was sent to 3544 Tait on a disorderly intoxicated subject. Nick Allison (W/M 26) was found to be intoxicated, creating a disturbance, and unable to care for himself. Allison was arrested for DCPI without incident.

2345 Ptl. Kowalski was on patrol on E. Dorothy, when he observed a vehicle, which was failing to maintain a continuous lane of travel. A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver, **Dustin B. Gibson, w/m/39**, was found to be OVI after failing the SFST's. Gibson was arrested and transported to the KPD Jail, where he tested a .210 BAC.

Wednesday, May 23, 2007

Thursday, May 24, 2007

0103 Ptl. D. Warren stopped a car for a speeding violation on S. Dixie at Cardington. The officer found that the driver-**Sabir A. Saklayan W/M/24** had been drinking. The subject failed the SFSTs and was taken into custody. The subject was brought to KPD for processing and refused to submit to Datamaster testing. The officer also found a container of suspected marijuana in the car during the inventory search.

0020 Ptl. Schomburg was dispatched to 5548 Bigger Rd, Apt. I, on the report of a "family trouble." Upon his arrival, he located one of the involved parties, **Jerome Walker, b/m/24**, who had an active warrant from Kettering Municipal Courts. Walker was arrested and transported to the KPD Jail without incident.

Tomlinson W/M/27** remove on of the large patio umbrellas from its stand and take it to his car. The subject placed the umbrella in the car and employees yelled at him to bring it back. The subject was then brought to KPD for processing. Friday, May 25, 2007

0138 Ptl. Mason and Lambert were dispatched to the area of Woodman Dr. and Forrer Blvd. on report of a theft that had just occurred and the suspect was walking toward Ascension Church. The complainant stated that **Diana L. Thompson W/F/23** had come to her house and asked to use the restroom. The suspect had a baby with her in a stroller. The subject used the restroom and then left the residence. The complainant discovered that several drawers from a jewelry box were gone along with the jewelry. The complainant followed the suspect as she called KPD. The suspect was found to be in possession of the stolen items. She was taken into custody and brought to KPD for processing. The baby was turned over to another family member who was called to the scene by officers.

Ptl. Pedro was dispatched to 3200 Waltham on an intoxicated male in the area. On arrival found the suspect lying on the grass at Waltham and Garrison. Jonathon Meyers was arrested for PI and transported to KPD jail.

1100 Ptl. S. Geisel was dispatched to Blockbuster on a theft. On arrival finds that all the merchandise had been returned. The suspect was seen driving away and was stopped his license were suspended. Paul Marcum was arrested and transported to KPD jail.

Stout contacted the second subject and was able to get a confession from him as well. **CHAD E. LUCKOSKI, W/M/16** and **HUBERT DEAN NEWTON, W/M/16** were arrested for the theft. Hubert Newton was also charged with Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

1935 Crews were sent to Wise Guys on a disturbance. Upon their arrival, Officer Lambert stopped **John M. Newcomb, w/m 31** who was involved in the altercation. The officers learned that a subject pointed to the women's restroom when John and his group asked where the restrooms were. They did not think it was funny. One of them punched the victim and John assaulted him by trying to bite his ear. John Newcomb was arrested for the assault and marijuana was found on him. He was arrested and taken to KPD jail where he was booked and processed. The other suspect fled the scene before officers arrived.

Friday, May 25, 2007

2258 Ptl. Lambert traveled to the Tim Horton's in Centerville on a warrant detail. Upon arrival he met a CPD crew and took custody of **Tommy L. Slagle wm/25**, wanted on two of our warrants, and transported him to the jail where he was served his copy of the warrants.

The driver, **Antwan Jennings bm/28** was found to be DUS and also had a Dayton PD warrant for DUS so he was arrested. A passenger in the vehicle, identified as **Reginald W. She refused to cooperate with the officers and became belligerent with her mother when she came to pick her up. After repeated warnings to leave and refusing to do so, **Ashley N. Frecker wf/20** was arrested for DC/PI. She was also issued a summons for underage consumption.

0410 Ptl. Mason and Ptl. Geckler went to the area of 538 Forrer on report of a subject looking into windows. The complainant gave a very detailed description of the suspect and the officers were able to locate him going into the apartment complex at 539 Forrer. He was found in apartment D. The suspect, **Terry J. Anspach wm/48** said that he was just letting his cat out and "smoking a joint." Ptl. Mason saw that Anspach was trying to force a cigarette package down into his couch between the cushions. When retrieved, Ptl. Mason found marijuana and also three plastic bags with suspected cocaine. Anspach was arrested for possession of drugs.

1858 Ptl. Price stopped a vehicle on Shroyer at Peach Orchard for a lanes violation. He reports that the occupants were acting very nervous and he had observed the driver make some furtive movements prior to his approach. After back up arrived the occupants were asked to step out of the vehicle and K-9 Bandit performed a canine sniff of the exterior of the vehicle and alerted to the presence of narcotics inside the vehicle. A search of the interior of the vehicle by Ptl. Price revealed a baggy of suspected crack cocaine along with three crack pipes.

Sunday, May, 27th, 2007
