## **POLICE BLOTTER**

Tuesday, May 27, 2008

1540 Off. C. Price was in the Elder Beerman's parking lot and was flagged down by the manager of Goodwill Enterprises. He advised that a subject had just taken property from the Goodwill Store at 1970 E. Dorothy Ln., gave the Officer a description and advised him that the suspect was in the area on foot. The subject was found inside the Dollar Tree store and taken outside to be questioned. The subject was carrying a large backpack. The subject was identified by the complainant, **JAMES L. WOODS, B/M/43** was arrested for the theft. Subsequent to his arrest a search of his person produced drug paraphernalia, he was charged with the possession of said paraphernalia.

2100 Off. J. Soto was sitting in the parking lot of the Kroger's Store at 2115 E. Dorothy Ln., he had just received a BOLO from Beaver Creek Pd ref. an att. purse theft at the Greens this evening. After other crews arrived the suspects were ordered from the vehicle at gun point. After the two occupants were secured, the vehicle was checked and the officers found property from several thefts which had occurred this date in Beaver Creek and also the purse the female had just taken from Krogers in Kettering. **CRYSTAL MARIE WERNER, W/F/22** and **ROBERT EDWARD WERNER, W/M/23** were arrested for Felony Theft and Receiving. Mr. Werner was also cited for DUS also, possible drug charges pending investigation by Det. Drerrup.
