POLICE BLOTTER

Tuesday, June 10, 2008

1826 Officer K. Tischler and Officer C. price responded to a disturbance at the Plum Creek Apartments at 3217 Wilmington Pike. Upon their arrival they arrested LaDonna S. Mercer (W/F/40) for Disorderly Conduct (Public Intox). She was transported to KPD Jail without incident.

The suspect was described as a tall black male in his early twenties with short hair, wearing a dark blue long sleeve shirt and dark short pants.
