POLICE BLOTTER

Tuesday, July 03, 2007

1345 Ptl. Kisaberth went to the Frisch's on SR-741 and S. Dixie on a warrant detail. Upon arrival he took custody of **Kathryn L. Norris wf/60** from a Miamisburg Officer. Norris, wanted on our warrant, original charge Passing Bad Checks, was transported to the jail where she was served.

Crews were sent to 2135 Whipp Road Apt. F on a family trouble. Dispatch advised the caller stated a subject was threatening to shoot his mother. Caller advised the subject does own several guns but was not in the apt. at this time to report further but stated he had one when she ran out. Units arrived on scene and encountered suspect in the apt. hallway. He was quickly taken into custody. The argument started over some fireworks. The son, **James Brandt w/m 23**, went into his room and got a gun. He threatened to shoot both his mother and sister if they did not give the fireworks back. Consent to search the apt. was granted and two handguns were recovered. Brandt was charged with two counts of Aggravated Menacing.

Ptl. Aldrich was sent to Meijers on a report of a shoplifter. Upon completion of his investigation he arrested **Dianne Henneken w/f 56** for the theft of \$289 in jewelry.

2200 Crews were dispatched to Jaffe Jewelers on Far Hills at Southmoor Circle N/W on the report of subjects running from building. When crews arrived they found that a window on the north side of the building had been broken out and that someone had been inside the store. A witness saw two subjects jump out of the window, get into a tan mini van and leave W/B on Stroop Rd.. One was described as a B/M/40's heavy set. The suspects stole diamond rings and pearls, unknown yet what the value of the stolen property might be.

Tuesday, July 03, 2007

2311 Ptl. J. Geckler and Ptl. W. Aldrich were dispatched to 1590 Beaver Ridge Dr Apt B on report of a family trouble involving a mother and adult daughter. When they arrived Ptl. J. Geckler made contact with the daughter, **Christina L. Wilson W/F 31**. Wilson was found to have an active Middletown Warrant. Wilson objected to being arrested wearing only her nightgown and refused to get into Ptl. J. Geckler's cruiser. Ptl. J. Geckler had to deliver a knee strike to the common peroneal as well as a drive stun to Wilson's right side with the taser to gain her compliance. Wilson was then transported to KPD Jail without further incident.

Wednesday, July 04, 2007

0034 Ptl. J. Soto observed a vehicle in the area of Lincoln Park and Ackerman driving with expired license plates and no license plate light. A traffic stop was initiated and the driver, **Robert C. Fabian W/M 38** was found to be under an FRA/Non-Compliance Suspension. Fabian was arrested and transported to KPD Jail for processing without incident.

0221 Ptl. B. Lambert observed a vehicle weaving in the area of West bound E. Dorothy Ln at Rushland. A traffic stop was initiated and the driver, **Brittany L. Schwieterman W/F 18**, was found to be drinking. After her performance on the SFSTs, Schwieterman was arrested for OVI and transported to KPD Jail. Once at the jail, Schwieterman tested a **.224** on the Datamaster.

Grimes was with other subjects, one of which was identified as **Steven D. Meadows W/M 43**. Meadows also had a Dayton warrant for FTA on traffic charges. Both men were arrested and transported to KPD Jail for processing without incident.

0247 Ptl. Sanders was on patrol in the area of Woodman, near Adventure, when he observed a car moving 10 mph under the speed limit and swerving in/out of its' lane of travel. A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver, **James Ray Key, w/m/31**, was found to be OVI and refused the SFST's. During the arrest, a bag of marijuana and rolling papers were located in Key's pocket. Key was arrested and transported to the KPD Jail where he refused all tests. He was charged with OVI, DUS, and Possession of Marijuana and Paraphernalia.

1907 Off. V. Mason and D. Kowalski were working the detail and Delco Park when they observed a Elizabeth Graf riding her bicycle on the sidewalk. There were hundreds of people walking toward the park to observe the fireworks. Ms. Graf was being reckless as she almost struck several people including a couple of small children. The officers advised her to be careful and she yelled profanities at them. Ms. Graf was warned a total of three times about her language but she refused to heed the warning. **ELIZABETH A. GRAF, W/F/46** was arrested for Disorderly Conduct and transported to the Kettering Jail.

Thursday, July 05, 2007

0103 Ptl. Geckler was on patrol in the area of Wilmington/Ansel, when he observed a vehicle stopped at the traffic light with only parking lights on. The vehicle was also partially over the solid yellow line. A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver, **Johnny C. Talley, b/m/35**, was found to be OVI after failing the SFST's. Talley was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail, where he tested .098 BAC. Talley was also charged with Endangering Children, due to the fact that his 3 year old son was in the car with him.

Thursday, July 05, 2007

As officers retrieved the suspects house keys he began to act in a turbulent and violent manner by hitting the air and then attempting to break his own door down. Lt. C. Bailey and Ptl. Drayton stopped the vehicle and arrested **David M. Woodard, w/m 23**, on the warrant. Woodard was transported to KPD jail for processing.

After performing field sobriety tests Hall was arrested and transported to KPD Jail whereupon he blew a .213 on the Datamaster.

Donnelly W/M 32** inside the store. Donnelly was located near the hot dogs and had made a mess with the food by spilling drinks, and hot dog sauce all over the counter and floor. Donnelly, who is from Covington, KY, appearing highly intoxicated and confused. Donnelly advised officers he was unsure of where he was, but it was somewhere definitely in Kentucky. Donnelly also stated he thought the date was July 13. Due to Donnelly's high level of intoxication he was arrested and transported to KPD Jail for processing. Once at the jail it was discovered Donnelly had smuggled a jelly doughnut out of Speedway down the front of his pants. Speedway declined to pursue theft charges.

0350 Ptl. G. Schomburg and Ptl. V. Mason responded to the area of Brydon and E. Dorothy Ln to assist Oakwood PD who were chasing a subject on foot in the area. An Oakwood officer had earlier discovered two white males going through a woman's purse, but the subjects had fled when the officer approached. Ptl. G. Schomburg located a subject, **Michael J. Shearer W/M 21**, matching the description given, running mest bound on Brydon at Hathaway. Ptl. G. Schomburg managed to take Shearer into custody. The Oakwood Officer advised he did fit the description of one of the subjects, but could not positively identify him. Shearer was found to be intoxicated to the point of being unable to care for his self. Shearer was arrested and transported to KPD Jail for processing. Oakwood is continuing their investigation of the stolen purse.

0520 Ptl. L. Sanders was dispatched to the area of Bella Villa Hall on County Line on report of a hit & run. After checking the area, the number one vehicle was located at 3248 Gracemore. The driver, **Jason N. Deckard W/M 38**, was found to have been drinking. Deckard also did not have permission to have the vehicle. Deckard was arrested for OVI and DWOC.

1802 Crews were sent to Meijers on a shoplifting involving three juveniles, ages 13, 12, and 11, running east from store security. They were running fast. Officers gave chase and tried to follow them as they ran into the neighborhood near the creek at Burning Tree. Officer Roberts kept an eye on them but they eventually lost him at Wilmington and Woodman. Crews kept on checking the area and found them and the stolen property behind CW Hittle Home Improvement. They confessed to the theft and were charged. They were released to one of there parents.

Friday, July 06, 2007

1902 Officer Burke and Gibson were sent to 2883 Red Oak on a domestic violence. Upon their arrival, they discovered that **Christopher D. Stone, w/m 43**, had been drinking and was upset over his wife's comments about his drinking and drug use. He then pulled her by the hair when she was pouring out his beer. He was arrested and taken to KPD jail where he was booked and processed.

2035 Officer Tischler was sent to the Circle K on Regent on a Hit and Run. The suspect, later identified as **Phillip R. Stephenson, w/m 57**, fled to his residence on Old Lane. Officer Tischler caught up to him and investigated the accident. Mr. Stephenson was intoxicated and failed the SFST. He was arrested and taken to KPD jail where he was booked and processed. He tested .264 on the datamaster.

Officer Gaudette and Bier were sent to Adams County to pick up **Paul E. Riley, w/m 34**, on our felony burglary warrant. He waived his Rule 4 hearing. They had left at the time of this daily but had not arrived back at KPD.

2210 Officer Burke was conducting an investigation and went to Troni's on E. Dorothy Ln. He ran **Mark J. Potenza, w/m 32**. He had a confirmed DPD warrant on him. He was arrested and taken to KPD jail where he was booked and processed.

Saturday, July 07, 2007

0049 Ptl. Schomburg observed two vehicles swerving all over the roadway in the area of West bound West Dorothy at Patterson Rd. One of the vehicles was also following the other too closely. A traffic stop was initiated and one of the vehicles stopped. The driver was identified as Ryan R. Reid W/M 21. Reid appeared to be under the influence of some sort of drug. While Ptl. Schomburg was awaiting another unit the other vehicle came back to the scene. The other driver was identified as Ashley A. Meadows B/M 49. Meadows also appeared to be under the influence of a drug. Ptl. Schomburg went back to his cruiser to await backup and when he got back out both driver's were passed out in their respective vehicles. Ptl. D. Warren arrived on scene and both Reid and Meadows failed field sobriety tests and were arrested. Both gave urine samples at the jail to determine what sort of drug was in their systems. A small amount of marijuana and unknown pills were located in the console of Reid's vehicle. Reid was issued a summons for the marijuana and the pills were sent to the Miami Valley Regional Crime Lab for analysis.

Saturday, July 07, 2007

0052 Ptl. Soto observed a vehicle in the area of Wilmington and Jaybee driving with no license plate light. A traffic stop was initiated and the driver, **Christopher M. Carr W/M 33** was found to be under suspension. Carr was arrested and transported to KPD Jail without incident.

0112 While working the OVI detail, Ptl. J. Kelch observed a vehicle fail to use their turn signal in the area of Smithville Rd and Forrer Blvd. A traffic stop was initiated and the driver, **Gregory S. Fiske II W/M 23**, was found to have been drinking as well as admitted to smoking marijuana earlier in the day. After failing field sobriety tests, Fiske was arrested and transported to KPD Jail where he blew a .125 on the datamaster. Fiske admitted to having a small amount of marijuana in the ashtray of the car. Fiske was cited for the marijuana as well as a pipe found in the glove box. Ptl. Kelch at first was unable to locate the marijuana Fiske admitted to having in the car, but it was later found in the possession of the passenger, **Candice E. Tudor W/F 23**. Tudor was also cited for Open Container as well as the possession of Fiske's marijuana (under 100g).

0202 Ptl. Tischler was dispatched to 3790 Hertland on report of a noise complaint. When he arrived he discovered three very intoxicated males sitting on the front porch and playing their stereo loudly. The owner of the residence, **Larry E. Blair W/M 31**, was extremely belligerent and continued to yell profanity. When Ptl. Tischler walked to his cruiser to run the three subjects on the MDT, Blair went back to his stereo and turned up the volume. Ptl. Tischler asked for additional crews. Ptl. Lambert and Sgt. Murchland were dispatched and all three subjects were subsequently arrested. During a search of the residence a 7 yr old girl was located asleep in a bedroom. Blair refused to give a name of someone who could care for the girl. Blair advised he didn't care what we did with her. The child's mother was located who responded to the scene to care for the child. Blair was arrested for Disorderly Conduct, Child Endangering and Disturbing the Peace. The other two subjects **Wallace D. Brewer W/M 65** and **James A. Young W/M 48** were arrested for Disorderly Conduct/PI

0215 Ptl. Sanders was dispatched to the Nutter Center to meet with Fairborn PD on a warrant service. Ptl. Sanders took custody of **Eric L. Harrison W/M 20** on our FTA/FTC warrant (original charge of expired registration). Harrison was transported to KPD Jail without incident.

0217 Ptl. Soto was dispatched to the Montgomery County Jail on a warrant service. Ptl. Soto took custody of **Moumoni H. Mahamadou B/M 29** on our FTA/FTC warrant (original charge of Disorderly Conduct). Mahamadou was transported to KPD Jail without incident.

Lambert agreed with Westbeld's assessment of his sobriety and Westbeld was arrested. Westbeld was transported to KPD Jail where he refused to take a breath test.

0253 Ptl. G. Schomburg observed a vehicle speeding in the area of Far Hills and David Rd. Ptl. G. Schomburg made contact with the driver who he found to have been drinking. The driver, **Phillip G. Rhodes W/M 23**, failed sobriety tests and was arrested. Once at KPD Jail, Rhodes tested a .102 on the datamaster.

Sunday, July 08, 2007

2010 Off. K. Tischler was dispatched to Fairborn PD to pick up a subject that was arrested on a Bad Check warrant through our department. Upon arrival he took one **BRIAN K. WHEELER, B/M/45** into custody and transported him back to the Kettering Jail without incident.

Monday, July 09, 2007
