POLICE BLOTTER

Tuesday July 10, 2007

1540 Ptl. Price saw a vehicle run a stop sign and stopped the driver. During the stop the driver was nervous and made movements inside the vehicle that warranted a pat down. During the pat down Ptl. Price found items he recognized as drugs. **Louis M. Matta (B/M 27)** was arrested for felony possession of drugs (Methadone) and cited for possession of marijuana.

2025 Ptl. Kelch located a subject at 514 Hadley Ave #4 wanted on an active KPD warrant. **Michael E. Greene (W/M 32)** was arrested on the warrant, original charge related to an OVI.

2120 Ptl. Burke located a suspicious subject at Dorothy Lane and Powhattan passed out at the bus stop. The subject had been drinking and was unable to care for himself. **Michael L. Joy (W/M 44)** was arrested for Disorderly Conduct-PI and transported to KPD jail without incident.

2143 Ptl. Kelch stopped a vehicle at Dorothy and Purdue for a traffic violation. The driver had been drinking and failed field sobriety tests. **David Shortt (W/M 45)** was arrested for OVI and transported to KPD jail where he refused to submit to a breath and urine test.

Tuesday July 10, 2007

2324 Ptl. J. Soto stopped a vehicle in the area of Wilmington Pk and E. Stroop Rd for having no rearview mirror and failing to signal. A check through LEADS/NCIC of the front seat passenger, **Joseph D. Martin B/M 23** revealed two active warrants. One warrant was through Kettering PD for FTA/FTC on an original charge of Possession of Drugs the other was through Yellow Springs for Contempt of Court on an original charge of Possession of Drugs. Martin was transported to KPD Jail without incident.

2343 Ptl. J. Geckler was dispatched to 1201 Colfax on report of a theft. When he arrived he was met by the Complainant, **Michael S. Dowlar W/M 28**. Dowlar wanted to report the theft of a trailer he had parked in front of his residence. Ptl. J. Geckler had in fact towed the trailer the previous night for a parking violation. Ptl. J. Geckler knew of an entered warrant for Dowlar. The warrant was for FTA/FTC on an original charge of a seatbelt violation was confirmed. Dowlar was then transported to KPD Jail without incident.

Wednesday, July 11, 2007

0038 Ptl. J. Geckler had been advised of a subject residing at 1538 Willamet who had an active warrant through our department. Ptl. J. Geckler and Ptl. R. Meno responded to the address and located **Charlean B. Boggs W/F 43**. Boggs was arrested for a FTA/FTC warrant. Boggs was transported to KPD Jail without incident.

0049 Ptl. L. Sanders observed a vehicle driving without headlights Westbound on E. Dorothy Ln from County Line. The vehicle was also later paced at 50mph in a 35mph zone near Woodman Dr. The vehicle was stopped and the driver, **Cori R. Funk W/F 27**, admitted to having had 6 or 7 beers. After performing field sobriety tests, Funk was arrested and transported to KPD Jail where she refused to take a breath test.

Wednesday July 11, 2007

1715 Crews were sent to 5/3 Bank, 2115 E. Dorothy, on a bank robbery that just occurred at the bank inside Kroger. The suspect fled on foot after presenting a note to the teller and leaving with an unreported amount of cash. A customer entering the bank saw the suspect running and confirmed with the teller he had been robbed and chased the suspect tackling him at the front door. The suspect was able to get outside where additional good Samaritans caught him and held him until police arrived. **Ruben L. Morton (B/M 36)** was arrested for Robbery and transported to KPD jail without incident. Detectives responded to continue the investigation.

1915 The customer that first gave chase and tackled the bank robbery suspect left the scene prior to police arriving due to several outstanding warrants. The customer later returned to continue assisting with the investigation. After an interview and written statement Ptl. Gaudette confirmed the warrants. **Gregory B. Kelson (W/M 35)** was arrested on 3 active warrants (Miami Twp, Bellbrook, and Greenville). Kelson was transported to KPD jail for processing.

2125 Ptl. Stout stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation at S. Dixie at the north city limits. A passenger in the vehicle had an active warrant from Monroe, Ohio. **Roland B. Sosa (H/M 35)** was arrested on the warrant, original charge Disorderly Conduct.

2127 Ptl. McGuire was dispatched to the area of Montgomery Square and Valleygreen on a subject passed out in a car port. He located the subject who had been drinking and was too intoxicated to care for himself. **Harry Petree (W/M 43)** was arrested for Disorderly Conduct-PI. Petree was transported to KPD jail without incident.

Thursday, July 12, 2007

0056 Ptl. D. Warren observed a vehicle South bound on Kettering Blvd near Hoyle Pl. When Ptl. D. Warren ran the license plate of the vehicle through LEADS/NCIC the registered owner was found to be under suspension due to a failure to reinstate. The driver was found to match the description of the registered owner and the vehicle was stopped on Fulton at W. Stroop Rd. When Ptl. D. Warren made contact with the driver he found him to be the registered owner, **Larry D. Adkisson W/M 30**, as well as having been drinking. After performing field sobriety tests, Adkisson was arrested for OVI and DUS and transported to KPD Jail without incident. Once at the Jail, Adkisson refused to submit to a breath test. Adkisson was then cited for the refusal as he had a prior incident in January 2007.

Thursday, July 12, 2007

0201 Ptl. J. Bodner stopped a vehicle in the area of Marshall Rd and Georgian for weaving. When Ptl. J. Bodner made contact with the driver, **John R. Lowe W/M 56**, he found Lowe had been drinking. After performing field sobriety tests, Lowe was arrested and transported to KPD Jail without incident. Once at the Jail, Lowe tested a .166 on the datamaster.

0318 Ptl. R. Meno observed a vehicle in the area of E Dorothy Ln and Woodman driving with expired plates. The vehicle was stopped and the driver, **Brandon L. Miller W/M 22**, was found to have been drinking. After Miller performed field sobriety tests he was transported to KPD Jail without incident. Once at the jail, Miller blew a .063 on the datamaster. A urine sample was also collected due to the suspicion of possible drug usage.

Crews were sent to the area of 2600 Aragon Ave. South on a report of a pit bull attack. Upon arrival it was discovered that a pit bull was out in the front yard of 2601 Aragon unattended. When the victim was walking her dog the pit bull attacked her dog then her when she tried to break them apart. The victim a 14 yoa female suffered a bite to the leg and was transported to KMC. Owner of the pit bull, **Daniel J. Hrachovina w/m 28** was cited for failure to confine a vicious dog.

2045 Ptl. Ferrell and Drayton were sent to 4309 Flowerdale on a family trouble. Upon completion of their investigation they arrested the son, **Jason M. Taylor w/m 19**, for disorderly conduct (PI). He did not reside at the address and was not welcome. After attempts to find a place for Taylor to go failed, he was placed under arrest.

Friday, July 13, 2007

2201 Ptl. L. Warren & Stout were dispatched to 1424 Central Park on a family fight. Upon arrival they found that both the husband and wife had assaulted each other and both were arrested for DV. The suspects, **Dianne M. Dupree, F/37 & Michael P. Dupree, M/39**, were taken into custody without incident. The children of the pair were released to the grandmother.

0005 Ptl. Meno stopped a motorist for an equipment violation and upon running the occupants found a passenger, **Jessy L. Coats, M/27**, wanted by Centerville PD on a falsification warrant. The subject was arrested without incident.

Friday, July 13, 2007

0230 Ptl. D. Warner was dispatched to the Wynds Apartments to meet with security ref. two subjects they had detained for possession of drugs. Crews arrived, two subjects were in handcuffs and both had marijuana and mushrooms on them when they were stopped by security. As the crews were investigating the first incident, two more subjects exited the building on the south end and they were stopped and questioned by Officer Aldrich. When they were patted down more drugs were found, the same kinds of drugs found on the first two subjects. All subjects were questioned and all subjects stated that they had purchased the drugs in Apt. #45 from a guy named "hippy." Detectives were called to the scene to prepare a search warrant. The first two subjects were released and the second two subjects were arrested.

1840 Off. L. Warren and M. Burke were dispatched to 3509 Tait Rd. on a "check on the welfare" of the resident. The resident's mother called from Arizona and asked if we would check on her daughter because she had spoken to her on the phone and she sounded highly intoxicated. Upon arrival the officers heard the def. screaming obscenities inside her house. She then came out on the porch and started yelling obscenities at the police officers. The officer's found the resident to be highly intoxicated and unable to care for herself. **CAREY R. SHONK, W/F/36** was arrested for public intoxication. Ms. Shonk was released from the jail at 2am and we got a call about an intoxicated female. Off.'s found the def. attempting to walk home, she was still intoxicated so she was transported to her residence by Off. Bower.

2125 Off. W. Vilelli was dispatched to Marion's Pizza, 50 E. Stroop Rd. on a custody exchange call. The officer met with a female who had a small child with her. She explained that the def. had kicked her and the child out, she had nowhere to go. She called the def. and asked him to bring her bus money so she and the child could get to Artemis House. When the male subject arrived his identity was checked and the officer found that the def. had an active warrant through the Kettering Muni. Ct. for FTC. **JAMES R. HOERNER, W/M/38** was arrested on the warrant. The female and child were transported to the Artemis House by the def.'s sister.

Saturday, July 14, 2007

1049 Dispatch received several calls of an erratic with in the city at several locations. Ptl G Geisel, Young observed the vehicle at Stroop and Shroyer. The driver Deborah Williams was stopped and found to have no OL. She also had an active warrant from Kettering. She was arrested and transported to MCSO jail.

Sunday, July 15, 2007

0155 Ptls. Mason, Sanders, Lambert, and Walker were dispatched to the area of 3240 Gracemore, on the report of two male subjects going through vehicles. Upon the officers arrival, they located **Michael J. Zennie, w/m/18**, and **Matthew L. Sentell, w/m/18**. Zennie was found to have a radar detector on him, along with a screwdriver and an extra pair of socks. Both subjects eventually gave statements, which connected them to thefts in the area. Both were arrested. Sentell was charged with RSP. Zennie was charged with Theft, Possession of Criminal Tools, and Criminal Damaging. Both were transported to the KPD Jail.

0526 Crews were dispatched to the area of Dorothy/Shroyer on the report of a man, who was hit by a car. A man, **Jason E. Cox, w/m/25**, was located on Dorothy, just east of Delaine, with head injuries. A friend told crews that he had been hit by a car. However, later at the hospital, Cox admitted that he had stumbled into the street and hit his head, after arguing with his friend.

0603 Ptls. Bower and Bodner were dispatched to the KMH Emergency Room on the report of a man attempting to obtain narcotics for recreational use. As they arrived, they located **Billie E Lai, w/m/37**, who admitted to the accusation. Lai was arrested, charged with Deception to Obtain Narcotics, and transported to the KPD Jail without incident.

Ptl Young was dispatched to MCSO on a warrant service. On arrival arrested Brandon Litsey and transported him to KPD jail.

1620 Crews assisted Beaver creek PD on an assault complaint from last evening. 2 of the participants had active warrants and reside in Kettering at 4784 Foxdale. Ptl. Stout located one of the subjects and arrested **Debra L. Hawn (W/F 47)** on an active KPD warrant, original charge FTC OVI. A second subject, **Brandy Hawn (W/F 24)** was also located and taken into custody by Beaver creek for menacing and an active Xenia warrant, original charge larceny.

1635 Ptl. Bier and Roberts responded to a disturbance at 3599 Waterbury. A 16 year old female came to the house over a dispute with the juvenile resident. The 16 year old attempted to assault the juvenile but instead assaulted her 61 year old grandmother and 17 year old friend. A juvenile arrest was completed on the 16 year old white female for 2 counts of assault.

Monday, July 16, 2007

0230. Ptl. Bodner was on patrol on Marshall, at Stroop when he observed a vehicle turn left in front of a another vehicle, nearly causing an accident. A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver, **Amanda M. Cummins, w/f/28**, was found to be OVI after failing the SFST's. Cummins was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail where she refused the datamaster.

0242 Ptls. Soto, Sanders, and Bier were dispatched to Norton's Tavern on the report of an "injury from a fall." Upon their arrival, they located **Glen M. Gordley, w/m/46**, who had fallen and hit his head. Gordley became belligerent with the KFD medics, so he was forced to go to the hospital to receive medical attention. He was issued a summons for Disorderly Conduct by Public Intoxication, and "Pink Slipped" into KMH.

Crews were sent to 1666 Cloverfield on a report of a disturbance. The complainant advised that two black males were in her yard refusing to leave and one urinated on the garage. She told dispatch that her husband went to get his gun. Upon arrival the area was checked and the males were goa. Ptl. Price located one of the subjects near the area of the Rustic Lane apts. He was found to be intoxicated and was the one identified to be the one who "relieved" himself on the garage. **Mark A. Melvin b/m 46** was arrested for PI.

2319 Ptl. Soto had stop a car for a traffic violation, in the area of Pauline/Flesher, and found that the driver, **Bland Ballard w/m/56**, was DUS. Ballard was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail without incident.
