POLICE BLOTTER

Tuesday, July 24, 2007

1605 Crews were sent to 4 Rue Royal on an assault complaint. Upon arrival they learned that the resident from Apt. #2 had assaulted the resident in #4 over a parking problem. Arrested for assault and criminal trespass was a **Dawn A. Baueries w/f 42.**

2201 Ptl. Price was sent to KPD Jail on a warrant service. He served **Thomas Helmers w/m 52** with his warrant.

2205 Ptl. Charles was sent to Krogers on E. Dorothy on a theft complaint. Upon completion of his investigation he arrested **Shawn M. Fournier w/m 21** for thefy of \$27.16 worth of beer and DVDs.
