POLICE BLOTTER

Monday, July 30, 2007

2342 Ptl. Stout was on patrol in the area of W. Dorothy, at S. Dixie, when he observed a vehicle squeal its' tires as the light changed colors. A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver **Bren t A. Elmore, w/m/32**, was found to be OVI after failing the SFSTs. Elmore was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail where he refused any further testing.

Tuesday, July 31, 2007

0055 Ptl. Stout stopped a vehicle on E Rahn Rd at Millcreek for a headlight violation. When Ptl. Stout made contact with the driver he found he had no photo ID. The driver stated he didn't know his SSN and then proceeded to give Ptl. Stout two different possible names. The name the driver gave came back to a subject who did not have a valid OL. Ptl. Stout arrested the driver for no OL and took him directly to the Montgomery County Jail to be fingerprinted for identification purposes. As Ptl. Stout arrived at the County Jail, the driver gave Ptl. Stout his correct identifiers. **Ronald D. Johnson B/M 40** was arrested for Falsification and DUS. Johnson was also found to have two active warrants. One warrant was for Failure to Register as a Sex Offender and the other was for Parole Violation.

Tuesday, July 31, 2007

0102 Ptl. Mason was driving through the parking lot of Sure Shots, 3121 E Dorothy Ln, when a vehicle almost struck him. Ptl. Bower stopped the vehicle at Blackhawk and Powhatten. The driver, **Monica A. Lawson W/F 22**, was found to have been drinking. After performing field sobriety tests, Lawson was arrested and transported to KPD Jail where she blew a .170 on the Datamaster. Lawson was also cited for expired plates and issued a summons for possession of drug paraphernalia.

0154 Ptl. Aldrich was on patrol in the area of E. Dorothy, near Woodlane Shopping Center, when he observed a vehicle exiting the Midas Muffler parking lot. The vehicle then began to move left of center several times, and almost struck a parked vehicle on Galewood Dr. A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver, **Erica Lynn Davis, w/f/29**, was found to be OVI. Davis was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail, where she refused any further testing,

1500 Officer Abrams and Kisaberth were sent to 3317 E. Stroop Rd. #103 to look for one **Scott A. Taylor, w/m 42**, on our warrant. His 4 year old son said he was hiding in another apartment. He was located and arrested. He was arrested and taken to KPD jail where he was booked and processed.

Officer Charles arrived and the subject confronted him from behind the office. The suspect, **Mark A. Shinkle, w/m 45**, had his hand in his pocket. He was intoxicated and would not show his hand. Officer Charles had removed his taser and then the suspect took his hand out of his pocket. He was disorderly and repeatedly called the officers names. He was arrested and taken to KPD jail where he was booked and processed.

1957 Ptl. Price and Roberts were sent to the Womens Health Clinic on W. Stroop on a report of possible drug activity. Upon arrival one of the subjects was found to be wanted on a Germantown PD Warrant. **James P. Donapin b/m 20** was arrested.

2025 Ptl. Lambert was sent to 515 Aberdeen on a report of a disturbance. The caller, **Aaron J. Meece w/m 24** was found to have an active Kettering Courts warrant and arrested without incident.

2057 Units were sent to Dorothy and Wilmington on a report of a Hit & Run. Unit 1 left the scene and was then involved in a second Signal 10 on Willamet and left the scene. About 15 minutes later Ptl. Drayton located unit #1 on Wilmington and made a stop at Imperial. The driver, **David E. Kohler w/m 51** was found to have been drinking. After failing SFST he was arrested and transported to KPD Jail where he tested .123 on Datamaster.

Wednesday August 1, 2007

1609 Ptl. Price stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation at Beaveridge and Lisbon. The driver, **Ted Osborn Jr. (W/M 54)**, had an active MCSO warrant, original charge probation violation. Osborn was arrested and transported to KPD jail for processing.

2120 Ptl. Price located a subject lying in the road at Smithville and Wilmington Pike. The subject claimed to be waiting on the bus but was intoxicated and was unable to care for himself. Ptl. Burke assisted and arrested **Larry V. Nevil (W/M 57)** for Disorderly Conduct –PI. Nevil was transported to KPD jail without incident.

Thursday, August 2, 2007

0249 Lt. Willcox observed a truck weaving on Wilmington Pk. near Smithville Rd. Upon stopping the truck, it was found that the driver-**Tracy E. Bloyd W/F/38** had been drinking. The subject failed the SFSTs and was brought to KPD for processing. The subject submitted to Datamaster testing and produced a .230 BAC.

Patrol crews over the last three days have taken a large number of Criminal Damages and Thefts. Ptl J Geisel developed information on two possible suspects. Officer Geisel spent what part of the day he could looking for the two. KPD was contacted by OSP Lt Price and advised that a trooper had stopped to check on a vehicle with a flat tire along I-75. The two suspects admitted to taking the vehicle from Kettering which was not yet reported. Items that were stolen were recovered.

1930 Ptl. Walker and Ferrell located a subject passed out behind Jackson Hewitt Tax Center, 4068 Wilmington. **James E. Riner (W/M 48)** was too intoxicated to care for himself and was arrested for Disorderly Conduct-PI. Riner was transported to KPD jail without incident.

2138 Crews were sent to the area of 2601 S. Aragon on a disturbance. When officers arrived one of the subjects fled on foot but was located after an extensive search of the area. **Matope Coleman (B/M 24)** was arrested for Obstructing Official Business and an active Xenia PD warrant, original charge RSP and Forgery.

2241 Several crews were sent to assist Oakwood PD in the 2600 block of Aerial after an Oakwood officer apprehended a subject in a stolen vehicle. 2 additional subjects fled on foot and officers continued a search at the end of shift.

Thursday, August 2, 2007

2300 Ptl. Burke was investigating a disturbance in the 2600 blk of Aragon. Upon identifying the participants, he attempted to talk to a subject later identified as **Matope A. Coleman B/M/24**. As he approached the subject, the subject fled on foot even though the officer gave clear commands to stop and cease his fleeing behavior. Officers responding to the area spent almost the next hour chasing the subject through the backyards in the neighborhood. The subject was finally captured in a garage where he was hiding after telling the residents that some subjects were chasing him. (He failed to tell the residents that the subjects were the police.) The subject was also found to have an active warrant from Xenia. The subject was brought to KPD for processing.

Friday, August 03, 2007

0100 Ptl. Bower responded to MCSO jail and took custody of **Stephen R. Fletcher W/M/25** on a warrant from our court. The subject was brought back to KPD for processing.

0420 Ptl. Geckler responded to 3217 Wilmington Pk. apt 18 on a noise complaint. Upon talking to the residents, he discovered that one subject- **Matthew A. Serrano W/M/19** had an active warrant from Dayton. The subject was taken into custody and transported to KPD for processing. (It was also learned that the subject was wearing an ankle monitoring bracelet as he is on parole for theft.)

1707 Ptl. Walker stopped a vehicle at Wilmington and Dorothy for a traffic violation and the driver had no driving privileges. **Mario Ramirez (H/M 48)** was arrested for DUS and transported to KPD jail without incident.

1758 Ptl. Price and McGuire were sent to Meijer on a shoplifter running from Loss Prevention. The thief was temporarily stopped by an unknown armed customer but continued running after the gun was put away. Officers were able to ID the suspect by a friend that the thief left behind and were able to talk him into returning to the store. **Daniel Brook (W/M 20)** was arrested for theft and transported to KPD jail for processing.

2055 Ptl. Burke located a DWOC vehicle at the Speedway, 3201 Wilmington. The driver, **William M. Franz (W/M 45)**, had no driving privileges and was arrested for DUS. Since the vehicle was reported DWOC this morning the owner had located it but then gave it to another subject who did not return it. Franz was not charged with the DWOC.

Saturday, August 04, 2007

0021 Ptl. G. Stout stopped a vehicle for weaving in the area of Marshall Rd and E. Stroop Rd. Ptl. G. Stout found the driver, **William L. Miller W/M 68**, had been drinking. After Miller performed field sobriety tests he was arrested for OVI and transported to KPD Jail for processing without incident. Once at the jail, Miller blew a .110 on the datamaster.

0215 Ptl. D. Bower assisted Sgt. Murchland at 2262 E David Rd Apt B on an investigation. Sgt. Murchland had observed a subject driving a vehicle who she believed had an active warrant. The driver had pulled into the apartment complex and gone into the above mentioned apartment. Sgt. Murchland found the driver and discovered he was not the wanted suspect. However, he was under an ALS Suspension and was issued a citation. Ptl. D. Bower then discovered a **Harold D. Phillips W/M 30**, hiding in a bedroom. Phillips was found to have 3 active warrants for FTA/FTC on traffic offenses. Phillips was arrested and transported to KPD Jail for processing without incident.

1100 Officers responded to KMH to meet security regarding a subject refusing to leave. Investigation revealed the subject was brought to KMH by Moraine FD medic with an injury to his foot. The subject had been issued a summons by Moraine PD for Disorderly – Intoxication and sent off to KMH by Moraine PD to be treated for the foot injury. Once at KMH the subject, who was still intoxicated, was treated by KMH for the injury. The subject however was not satisfied with the treatment and was demanding more. The hospital discharged the subject and demanded he leave the property. The subject refused to leave. Arrested for Trespassing was **Mario A. Ajak, B/M/22** of 2682 Cobble Cir. # 7 Moraine. The suspect was conveyed to KPD w/o incident.

1105 Officers responded to 527 Corona on report of an intoxicated subject creating a disturbance. Officers located a subject in the rear sitting by a dumpster yelling at the sky. Further investigation revealed the subject was very intoxicated and unable to care for himself. Arrested for Disorderly – Intoxication was **Mark Z. Gillespie W/M/56** of 533 Wiltshire Blvd. Apt. B. The suspect was conveyed to KPD Jail w/o incident. Suspect is currently on parole.

1755 Crews were sent to the Krogers at 2115 E. Dorothy on a report of a Fraud. The suspect fled the scene prior to arrival but was found in the area. After Positive ID by the store management, **Twanette M. Hill b/f 34** was arrested for theft. Hill was a suspect in a previous theft by deception from the same Krogers and charged with that offense also. Hill was attempting to return store merchandise she did not purchase with the use of a altered sales receipt.

Sunday, August 5th, 2007

2330 Off. W. Aldrich was dispatched to Stebbins H.S. in Riverside to meet with a Huber Heights Police Officer ref. a subject they had arrested on a Kettering warrant. Off. Kash, HHPD, turned over one **ERIC DANIEL SORRELL, W/M/22**, Mr. Sorrell was then transported to the Kettering Jail where he was served with a copy of the warrant.

0052 Off.'s B. Lambert and G Stout were in the area of Acorn and Oakley when they heard the sound of male voices yelling and screaming. The officers drove toward the sounds and found (3) adult males fighting on the lawn of the residence at 2600 Oakley Ave. The males were all yelling obscenities at each other, rolling around on the ground. Two of the males were arrested disorderly conduct, **DONALD C. ALLEN, W/M/49** and **WILLIAM M. HATTON, W/M/25**. There were approx. 6 to 8 adults at the residence having a party, all had been drinking alcohol.

0200 Crews responded to a disturbance on Ansel Dr., it was reported that several subjects were fighting in the front yard. Upon arrival crews were told that the subject who had started the fight had left on foot, he was a large W/M wearing plaid shorts and no shirt. They described him as being very intoxicated. Sgt. J. Winters found the subject on Rushland at Osage. **BRIAN MICHAEL HOLLEY, W/M/21** was arrested by Off. D. Warren for Disorderly/PI. The residents at 1116 Ansel Dr. refused to cooperate any further ref. any altercation that may have occurred at the residence.

0120 Off. R. Meno observed the def. driving erratically and made a stop on Wilmington at Devon. The driver failed the FST and was placed under arrest for OVI. **NORA C. PIERCE, W/F/45** was transported to the Kettering Jail where she refused to take the Datamaster. Ms. Pierce was also charged with Possession of Drug Paraphernalia after they found a bag with suspected cocaine residue.
