## **POLICE BLOTTER**

Tuesday, September 18, 2007

1528 Off. M. Walker was on patrol when he observed a Dodge van traveling at a high rate of speed N/B on Woodman Dr. @ Patricia Dr.. The vehicle was stopped at Adventure Dr.. When the officer ran the driver through LEADS he found a history of drugs. The driver was acting very nervous and was asked to step out of the vehicle. The K-9 officer and Bandit were on scene and Bandit alerted to the driver's side door. The driver continued to deny that there was any contraband in the vehicle. Bandit located a pipe with suspected marijuana in it as well as a small amount of suspected marijuana in a bag. **RICHARD L. PIATT, W/M/26** was issued a traffic citation for 50/35 and two citations, one for the paraphernalia and one for the under 100g's of marijuana.

1916 Off. C. Price made a traffic stop on Tabor Av. just off Wilmington Pk. for speed. It was apparent that both the driver and the passenger had been drinking. The driver was checked through BMV and was found to be driving under suspension for a drug related violation. Off. B. Lambert arrived on scene. Driver stated that he had driving privileges to and from work. He told the officer when he was first stopped that he and his female passenger were going bowling, not to work. Bandit alerted on the females purse which was on the passenger side floor. The officer checked the purse and found a marijuana pipe and Schd. IV drugs. **MICHAEL NEWMAN, W/M/28** was arrested for DUS and Drug Possession. **CARRIE A. CHATTERTON, W/F/30** was cited for Drug Paraphernalia and Drug Possession.

## Tuesday, September 18, 2007

2250 Off. W. Aldrich and D. Gaudette were dispatched to 2211 E. David Rd. on the report of a man trying to get into the complainant's first floor apartment. Upon arrival they found the complainant out on his patio with a large hammer, defending his property. The suspect was found a few feet away, he was highly intoxicated, barely able to stand. The suspect told the complainant that he just needed a room for the night. **WILLIAM N. APPEL, W/M/45** was arrested for PI and transported to the Kettering Jail. **The suspect lived on Orangewood Dr.** in Kettering.

We also had (6) traffic accidents this afternoon. That is (11) on this shift in two days.

## Wednesday, September 19, 2007

0247 Ptl. Sanders was on patrol in the area of Valleywood Dr. & Bobbie Pl., when he observed a vehicle weaving in/out of its' lane. A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver, **Kara K. Tobe, w/f/25**, was found to be OVI. She refused the SFST's. Tobe was arrested and transported to the KPD Jail, where she refused any further testing.

While speaking with the manager I was notified that a subject who had been trespassed from the property was at 4841 Far Hills. When the subject was confronted he complained about chest pains, he is a chronic alcoholic. A medic was called and the subject was found not to need hospitalization. **WILLIAM T. SHOCKEY, W/M/44** was issued a citation for Trespass.

## Wednesday, September 19, 2007

1652 Off. C. Price and B. Charles were dispatched to 4492 Sunray Dr. on the report of a possible Domestic Dispute. Upon arrival they made contact with the caller who was the daughter of the female suspect. She stated that her mother was highly intoxicated and was throwing things (televisions) around the house. She stated that her mother had assaulted her stepfather and that her stepfather and stepsister were upstairs with her mother. Crews responded to the second floor of the residence and found the husband and other daughter holding the suspect down on the floor. The suspect appeared to be highly agitated and was trying to get free. The officers were forced to deploy their Taser's twice to gain compliance. **DOROTHY L. CRAFTON, W/F/43** was arrested for Domestic Violence. It was learned that she had been drinking beer and Tequila all afternoon.

1730 Off. M. Steffano and J. Kelch were dispatched to Heil Bros. because the subject who had stolen a mower from them on Sept. 6<sup>th</sup>, was back and had the mower on a trailer attached to his truck. According to the employees, the suspect came into the business to purchase a part to repair the stolen mower. The officer's talked to the original complainant and after not being able to verify the suspects address or anything else. He was arrested for Felony receiving. **MICHAEL W. SHELTON, W/M/44** was transported to the Kettering Jail and the Detectives were notified.

## Thursday, September 20, 2007

He was arrested and taken to KPD jail where he was booked and processed. Once in the jail, he tested .22. An inventory search of the vehicle turned up some marijuana and pipe.
