## **POLICE BLOTTER**

Tuesday, September 25, 2007

0756 Ptl. Rustad attempted to stop a vehicle for speeding in a school zone on E. Stroop. The vehicle refused to stop, and a pursuit ensued. Due to speed, reckless driving and the fact the pursuit was approaching another school zone, Ptl. Rustad ended the chase. However, the vehicle then got stuck in traffic in the curb lane across from 1150 W. Dorothy and was essentially boxed in. Ptl. Caldwell and Ptl. Rustad approached the vehicle and ordered the driver to exit. He refused. The window of the vehicle was down so Ptl. Rustad deployed the taser and the suspect complied. **Aaron C. Watts bm/30** was arrested for fleeing, reckless operation, DUS, and also several outstanding warrants from other jurisdictions.

0935 Ptl. Pedro and Ptl. Mannix went to Meijers to assist loss prevention with the trespassing of two subjects. They had dumped some merchandise prior to arrival and fled the store. One subject was located at E. Stroop and Wilmington Pike. **Donovan J. Creech wm/32** admitted to stealing several video game controllers. He was cooperative and told Ptl. Pedro the identity of the other suspect and the vehicle they were driving. Stolen merchandise was located in the vehicle, so it was towed pending further investigation. Creech was issued a summons for theft.

1200 Ptl. Kisaberth traveled to the Miami County Jail on a warrant detail. Upon arrival he took custody of **Richard K. Wasson wm/51**, wanted on our warrants, original charge of expired plates, and transported to the jail where he was served.

## Tuesday September 25, 2007

1550 Ptl. Price stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation (tinted windows) at 2361 S. Smithville. After being cited for the violation the driver became disorderly and began shouting obscenities in front of numerous customers. **John P. Carter (W/M 21)** was arrested for disorderly conduct and transported to KPD jail for processing.

1700 Ptl. Lambert was sent to 557 Wiltshire for a violation of a protection order. The caller reported her ex-boyfriend had made numerous phone calls to her in violation of an active protection order. The suspect was located by Riverside PD and taken into custody. Ptl. ## Wednesday, September 26, 2007

0500 Ptl. Stout was dispatched to the Montgomery County Jail on a warrant detail. When he arrived he took custody of **Tuananh Mai, A/M/20** and transported him to KPD Jail where Ptl. Bodner served him with the warrant. The warrant was for FTA/FTC on an original charge of Possession of a Controlled Substance.

1511 Off. D. Gaudette was dispatched to Fairmont H.S. to meet with the complainant's who wanted to report a Protection Order violation. The complainant reported that her ex-husband went to Fairmont High School to pick up their daughter's violin. Their daughter, who attends Fairmont is one of the protected parties and she was in school at the time he was on the property. **ERIC S. SHEAFFER, W/M/46** was served with a copy of the protection order on Sept. 25<sup>th</sup>, 2007 by MCSO, he was arrested for violating a protection order.

## Thursday, September 27, 2007

2332 Ptl. Soto had initiated a traffic stop at 539 Forrer, and while speaking with the driver, the owner, **Andrew N. Christenson, w/m/24**, came out of his residence to ask what was going on. Christenson had an active warrant for his arrest from the Kettering Municipal Courts. Christenson was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail without incident.

0005 Ptl. Schomburg was on patrol near Bigger/Polen, when he ran a computer check on a vehicle and found that the license plates had expired. A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver, **Ryan V. 1634 Off. M. Walker was traveling S/B on Wilmington Pk when he observed the def. walking in front of the Rustic Lane Apt.'s. The officer knew that the def. had an active warrant on her so he stopped the def. and asked her about the warrant. She stated that she had been to court and taken care of the warrant. A check through NCIC showed that she was wrong. **ALECIA M. FRISCH, W/F/48** was arrested and transported to the Kettering Jail where she was served with a copy of the warrant.

1707 Off. D. Gaudette, M. Woolf and Lt. Bailey were dispatched to the Arby's at 2305 S. Smithville Rd. on the report of an intoxicated female who was passed out in the parking lot. Upon arrival they found the def. lying next to a utility pole with her pants & underwear pulled down to her ankles, passed out. It took several minutes to revive the subject and she eventually pulled up her pants. **KATHLEEN M. KETTERING, W/F/58** was found to be highly intoxicated and she had three outstanding warrants, two from Kettering and one from another jurisdiction (Dayton). She was issued summons for open container and public intoxication. She was transported to the Kettering Jail and then later transported to the MCSO jail.

1720 Off. M. Steffano was on routine patrol in the area of Woodman Dr. and Patricia Dr. when he ran the registration on a vehicle and it showed that the registration was expired. A stop was initiated and it was found that the driver had two warrants through MCSO, one a felony for probation violations related to drug charges. **KARLA J. SENSABAUGH, W/F/33** was arrested and transported to the Kettering Jail.

## Friday, September 28, 2007

0236 Ptl. J. Geckler observed a vehicle impeding traffic in the area of 2604 West Ave. Ptl. J. Geckler did a routine check of the license plate through LEADS and found the owner to have an expired driver's license. The vehicle was stopped in the area of Circleview and Wiles. 0843 A transformer behind 2250 E. Stroop blew up causing a significant power outage in the area of Woodman and E. Stroop and loss of power to several traffic lights. Crews were tied up for some time directing traffic at intersections for some time as a result.

1740 Off. Price was sent to Value City, 1724 Woodman, on a female shoplifter in custody. He arrested **Shana M. Brown (W/F 25)** for theft after she attempted to leave the store without paying for \$268.88 of merchandise. Brown was transported to KPD jail for processing.

2100 Off. K. Tischler was dispatched to the Greene County Jail to pick up a subject they had arrested on a Kettering warrant. Upon his arrival he took **JAMES M. BINOEDER, W/M/26** into custody and transported him to the Kettering Jail where he was served.

## Saturday, September 29, 2007

The driver also improperly used his turn signal. The vehicle was stopped and the driver, Richard J. Kerstetter W/M/31 was found not only be the registered owner, but also had been drinking. After performing field sobriety tests, Kerstetter was arrested for OVI and DUS and transported to KPD Jail. Once at the jail, Kerstetter refused the Datamaster. Due to a prior conviction, Kerstetter was also cited for the refusal.

Saturday, September 29, 2007

0120 Ptl. Meno stopped a vehicle in the area of Doris and Glaser for failure to dim his headlights. The passengerr, **Cole S. Traylor W/M/40** was found to be listed on the Dayton Capias Sheet. The warrant for FTA/FTC on an original charge of Public Intox was confirmed and Traylor was arrested and transported to KPD Jail for processing.

0140 Sgt. Murchland stopped a vehicle in the area of Farrington and Glenn Abbey for turn signal and lane violations. The driver, **Shawn D. Perkins W/M/33** was found to have been drinking. After performing some field sobriety tests, Perkins was arrested for OVI and transported to KPD Jail. Once at the jail, Perkins refused the Datamaster.

She was transported to the Kettering Jail and her sister bonder her out a short time later.

1850 Off. M. Walker and K. McGuire were dispatched to 718 Wiltshire on a disturbance. Upon their arrival they found a highly intoxicated subject in front of 2411 Broadmoor Blvd. This subject has been arrested several times in the past for PI. **WILLIAM C. BECK, W/M/52** was arrested for Public Intoxication and transported to the Kettering Jail.

1853 Off. W. Aldrich was dispatched to Whipp Rd. @ Wilmington Pk. to meet with a Centerville Police Officer to take into custody a subject they had arrested on a Kettering warrant. **JUSTIN ADAM LONDON, W/M/29** was arrested and transported to the Kettering Jail where he was served.

2300 Ptl. K. Tischler and Sgt. H. Murchland were dispatched to 1424 Central Park on report of a family trouble. When Ptl. Tischler arrived he could hear the male resident, **Michael P. Dupree W/M/39** yelling profanities from two houses away. Further investigation revealed Dupree had assaulted his wife. Dupree was arrested for Domestic Violence and Disturbing the Peace and transported to KPD Jail for processing.

## Sunday, September 30, 2007

0205 Ptl. J. Bodner stopped a vehicle in the area of Far Hills and Stroop for weaving and a red light violation. The driver, **Christopher R. Delaet W/M/29** advised Ptl. Bodner he had been drinking and had approximately 4-5 beers. After performing field sobriety tests, Delaet was arrested for OVI and transported to KPD Jail for processing. Once at the jail, Delaet tested a .096 on the Datamaster.

0405 Ptl. D. Bower stopped a vehicle in the area of E Dorothy and Valleywood for a red light and improper turn violation. Ptl. Bower found the driver **Matthew A. Seibert W/M/20** had been drinking. After performing field sobriety tests, Seibert was arrested for OVI and transported to KPD Jail for processing. Once at the jail, Seibert test a .057 on the Datamaster.

1129 Ptl Tobias was dispatched to 242 Rahn on a missing adult female w/Alzheimer's. The female had been missing for over two hours at the time KPD was called. A general search of the area could not locate the victim. Information was obtained for a CODE RED notification. Dispatched was unable to get the system to function properly and Lt Burian was contacted. The victim was located at 642 Rahn at approx 1300 and returned to her home. Lt Burian is to check on Monday to see what the systems problems were.

## Monday, October 1, 2007

0102 Ptl. Bower was on patrol in the area of Wilmington/Dorothy, when he observed a vehicle almost run through red light. A computer check was run on the license plate, and it was found that the owner's OL was under suspension. The driver's description fit that of the owner, **Katasha L. Sampson, b/f/35**, so the stop was initiated. Sampson was the driver, and was subsequently arrested for DUS, and transported to the KPD Jail without incident.

## Monday, October 01, 2007

2052 Officer Gaudette was advised that there were signed charges for one Eric S. Schaiffer, w/m, 46, for a TPO violation that occurred on days concerning his daughter who is attending Fairmont. Officer Gaudette and Lambert located him at his home and arrested him. He was arrested and taken to KPD jail where he was booked and processed.

## Tuesday, October 2, 2007

2330 Ptl. Bodner and Ptl. Schomburg were dispatched to the Kroger, E. Strop, on an intoxicated male subject, urinating in the flowers. Upon their arrival, they located Terry L. Bach Jr., w/m/29, who was intoxicated, and unable to care for himself. Bach was arrested and transported to the KPD Jail, where he was held for bond.

0301 Ptl. Geckler was on patrol in the area of S. Dixie/Sacramento, when he observed a vehicle with one headlight out. A traffic stop was initiated, and an active warrant was found for the passenger, Tiffany M. Blue, b/f/22. Blue was arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail without incident.

0411 Ptl. Bodner and Ptl. Warner were dispatched to 141 Sheringham, Apt. C, on the report of a Robbery(Home Invasion), where two individuals entered the apartment by kicking the front door, and pointing a gun at the resident, and ordering him to open his safe. The resident grabbed the gun, and they wrestled over it. The resident was struck in the head with the gun, and then he yelled at the subjects to get out of his apartment. He then chased them out of the front door. A track was attempted, and it appeared that the suspects left the complex in a vehicle. No suspects at this time.
