POLICE BLOTTER

Tuesday, October 2, 2007

1333 Ptl. S. Geisel went to the Sportsplex on I-675 on a warrant detail. Upon arrival he took custody of Sylvia M. Owens wf/20, wanted on our active warrant, original charge of expired plates, and transported her to the jail without incident, where she was served.

2356 Ptl. Schomburg stopped a vehicle in the area of Wilmington and Eldorado for weaving. The driver, **Melanie L. Kirchoff W/F/26** was found to be under a Non-Compliance Suspension. Kirchoff was arrested for DUS and transported to KPD Jail for processing without incident.

Wednesday, October 3, 2007

Thursday, October 04, 2007
