POLICE BLOTTER

Tuesday, October 30, 2007

Ptl Tobias was dispatched on a warrant service to Moraine PD. On arrival arrested Lashona Walker on an outstanding Kettering warrant. She was transported to KPD jail.

Ptl Abrams was dispatched to Dot,s on a theft. On arrival arrested Rhonda Hughes after she attempted to leave the store without paying for merchandise.

1719 Officer Gibson was sent to Miami County Jail to pick up one **Jessica D. Taylor, w/f 27**, on our warrant. She was arrested and taken to KPD jail where she was booked and processed.

1820 Officer Burke ran a registration of a vehicle where the owner, **Valerie L. Vance, w/f 37**, had a KPD warrant for her. The operator matched the physical description of the owner.
