## **POLICE BLOTTER**

Tuesday, December 04, 2007

0943 Ptl Franklin, Rustad were dispatched to Krogers 2115 E Dorothy on a theft. On arrival arrested Matthew Green after he failed to pay for a bottle of Vodka. His partner Kari Epperson was also arrested for PI. Both were transported to KPD jail.

1900 Officer Drayton was sent to MCSO jail to pick up one **Kenneth E. Mullinex, w/m 26**, on our warrant. He was arrested and taken to KPD jail where he was booked and processed.

2018 Officer Beir was sent to the Red Horse Inn in Moraine to meet Moraine PD to pick up one **Danny W. Brewer, w/m 45**, on our warrant. He was arrested and taken to KPD jail where he was booked and processed.

2350 Ptl. Geckler was on patrol in the area of Woodman/Bingham, when he ran a computer check on a vehicle, and found that the owner had a suspended OL. The driver's description fit that of the owner, so a traffic stop was initiated. The driver was the owner, **Jashaun A. Kelly, b/m/29**, so he was subsequently arrested and transported to the KPD Jail. There was also a warrant for his arrest from Dayton PD.

Wednesday, December 05, 2007

0243 Ptl. Lambert and Ptl. Bodner were dispatched to the area of 4010 Royal Oak on the report of a subject, later identified as **Scott P. Sensel, w/m/40**, going through cars. Lambert responded on bike patrol, and by tracking him through the snow, located him at 546 Lamont. He was attempting to get into a vehicle, but he ran into the apartment building instead. Sensel is suspected in attempting to get into numerous cars and stealing items. Sensel had a large amount of money on him, which was later identified as money from the vehicles. Sensel was arrested and charged with theft, receiving, and criminal tools.

0448 Ptl. Geckler was dispatched to Far Hills/David, on the report of a "subject passed out behind the wheel." Upon his arrival, he found **Justin T. Goubeaux, w/m/36**, passed out, with his foot on the brake, and the car in drive. Goubeaux was arrested, charged with OVI, and transport to the KPD Jail, where he tested .162 BAC.

1530 Ptl. K. McGuire was sent to Meijer on a shoplifter in custody. The suspect concealed \$87.11 and attempted to leave the store without paying for it when he was detained by store security. **Ryan R. Reid (W/M 22)** was arrested for Theft and transported to KPD jail for processing.

1537 Ptl. Charles was sent to 3038 Fountain on a criminal damaging. His investigation showed that the complainant's ex-boyfriend damaged her vehicle. **Kristopher S. McClure (W/M 25)** was cited for criminal damaging.

1925 Officers were sent to Hadley Ave. re: a subject banging on doors. They located a male subject at 539 Hadley who broke the building's front door and an apartment door to gain entry. The subject injured his hand while breaking the doors, requiring medical attention. The subject was intoxicated and entered his brother's apartment by force because he forgot his key. Ptl. Aldrich issued a summons to **Michael P. Cramer (W/M 31)** for criminal damaging.

2215 Crews were sent to Meijer on a subject crawling on the ground near the front doors. Ptl. McGuire located the subject who clearly had too much to drink to care for himself. **Thomas D. Stork (W/M 53)** was arrested for Disorderly Conduct – Public Intoxication and transported to KPD jail for processing.

Numerous accidents occurred as the wet roads froze during rush hour and into the early evening.

## Thursday, December 06, 2007

0401 Ptl. D. Warren was dispatched to Meijer on the report of a theft. By the time he had arrived, the suspects had left the store without the merchandise. He was given the description of the suspect vehicle, and located it at Meijer E./Wilmington. A traffic stop was initiated, and the driver, **Terry W. Csaszar, w/m/28**, was found to be DUS. Csaszar was arrested and transported to the KPD Jail. A passenger, **William A. Lairson, w/m/34**, had an active warrant for his arrest from MCSO. Lairson was also arrested and transported to the KPD Jail without incident.

0515 Ptl. Schomburg and Ptl. Sanders were dispatched to 148 Canterbury on the report of a returned DWOC, and the person who returned it, **Heidi M. Lawhorn, w/f/39**, had active warrants from MCSO, and Beavercreek. Lawhorn was located, arrested, and transported to the KPD Jail without incident.

1740 Super Cuts in the 4000 Block of Wilmington Pk. was robbed by a b/m, dressed in black with a large knife. He fled the building and a dog track indicated he possibly got into a car parked in the Ace Hardware Store on E. Stroop Rd. Detectives were called and the investigation continues.

## Friday, December 07, 2007

0207 Ptl. G. Stout stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation in the area of Wilmington Pk and Woodman Dr. A passenger in the vehicle, **Sean M. Fournier W/M/23**, was found to have an entered warrant through our department for FTA/FTC on an original charge of Theft. The warrant was confirmed and Fournier arrested. Fournier was transported to KPD Jail for processing without incident.

0341 Ptl. D. Warren was dispatched to the area of 3535 Southern on report of a single car Sig 10. When he arrived he discovered the driver, **Kelly N. Bilinski W/F/25**, had been drinking. After performing field sobriety tests, Bilinski was arrested and transported to KPD Jail for processing without incident. Once at the jail, Billinski refused the Datamaster.

0413 Ptl. G. Stout was dispatched to 5510 Chimney Circle Apt 1C on report of a disturbance. One of the participants, **Tony-Michael A. Saturday, December 08, 2007

Upon checking the area, officers found numerous cars that had been entered by the suspects and on vehicle at 2500 S. Patterson had a DVD player stolen. This property was recovered by officers at the area where the first subject was apprehended. Both subject brought to KPD for processing on theft and receiving stolen property. The juvenile was also found to be wearing a police style badge on his belt that had been stolen from another car but the subject could not remember which street or car it had come from. Handcuffs, stun gun, collapsible police baton holder and other items were also recovered but as of this time the owners had not been located.

**Excellent job by crews and dispatchers in coordinating information on this theft and the suspects' locations as there were numerous Code 2 calls coming in from different areas of the city at the time of this incident.**

0114 Ptl. Mason responded to a possible burglary at 2073 Richfield where the suspect was still in the house. Upon arrival, the complainant stated she woke up to find a female in her bedroom yelling at her. The suspect had fled out a back door. The officer returned to his cruiser to find the suspect-**Jennifer L. Hoffman W/F/22** standing near the cruiser. The suspect insisted that it was her house and there were people inside. She was taken into custody and brought to KPD for processing. The suspect was very intoxicated and had gone to the right house number, but the wrong street.

0355 Ptl. Soto responded to 3044 Blackhawk on report of a disturbance. Upon arrival the officer located **Lisa M. Bell W/F/22** who was wanted on 2 warrants. The subject was taken into custody and brought to KPD for processing.

2033 Ptl. Steffano and Woolf went to 1640 Briedweng where they arrested **Shannon Lumpkin w/f 26** on a charge of Domestic Violence. Shannon had assaulted her husband earlier in the evening.

Sunday, December 09, 2007
