Monday, December 6, 2010

1718 An officer was dispatched to I675 and SR35 to meet with Fairborn Police on a warrant detail. Upon arrival, Brian J. Knouse, w/m/39, was taken into custody on an active Kettering FTC warrant. Mr. Knouse was transported to KPD jail without incident. 09-33995

Tuesday, December 7, 2010

0150 An officer was dispatched to 2219 Farmside Dr. on the report of a domestic violence complaint. Investigation revealed the complainant's boyfriend and father of her child had assaulted her, broken her phone, and held her against her will prior to leaving. Off.
