## **POLICE BLOTTER**

Tuesday, December 11, 2007

1610 Officer Drayton was sent to Greene County Jail to pick up **Matthew J. Wasky, 33**, on our warrant. He was arrested and taken to KPD jail where he was booked and processed.

1647 Off. M. Woolf was dispatched to the Kroger's store at 2100 E. Whipp Rd. on the report of a shoplifter being detained. Upon arrival the officer met with the store security officers and after talking with them contacted Sgt. Winters and requested that he be allowed to issue a citation in lieu of arrest. **LUCY HAUBER, W/F/47** was issued a citation for Theft.

1719 Off. W. Miller and R. Roberts were dispatched to the 100 blk. of W. Dorothy Ln. on the report of a vehicle crash and that one of the drivers was agitated. Upon their arrival they learned that the at fault driver left E/B on E. Dorothy Ln. in a white pickup truck, front end damage. Witnesses stated that the driver might be intoxicated. Off. A. The driver **Charles E Brummit w/m 32** fled the vehicle but was apprehended with the assistance of K9 unit. ## Saturday, December 15, 2007

Ptl Kisaberth was dispatched to 1901 W Stroop on a warrant service. On arrival met with Moraine PD and took custody of Tiffany Waterhouse. She was transported to KPD jail.
