



The city's police and engineering departments are joining forces to help advance the bicycle safety program.

A free Kettering bicycle Registration program coordinated by the City of Kettering's Police Department and Engineering Safety Section serves to deter theft and aid in returning recovered property. As part of the program, owner's name and contact information is recorded, along with the bicycle make, model and serial number. Bicycle owners receive a copy of their registration information and a tamper-resistant registration sticker will be affixed to a visible area on the bike. The information is then entered into a city database in case the bicycle is ever reported stolen and allows the Kettering Police Department to track ownership of a bicycle.

The registration procedure is simple. Pick up a registration form at the Kettering Government Center- south building, 3600 Shroyer Rd. or print a form from the city website at www.ketteringoh.org. Complete the form and bring it with your bicycle to your pre-arranged time. Only bicycles with serial numbers can be registered through the program

Bicycle Registration is offered at no charge to area residents. To reserve a time slot on the listed dates please call 937-296-2520. The Engineering Safety Section or Police personnel will record the registration form and place a sticker on your bike:
