The City's Safety Supervisors, Police and Fire personnel teach the class lessons and are assisted by local student volunteers. Safety Village consists of scaled down streets, buildings and intersections constructed at one of the City of Kettering's elementary schools. Safety professionals believe that practicing safety skills is an important step in helping your child understand and feel comfortable with traveling to and from school.
