## CAMP INFORMATION

### Camp Adfunture

Ages: 6 – 9 years      Extended care hours are available.

Camp Adfunture will be located at the Kettering Recreation Complex. Activities will include one field trip a week, swimming three times a week, as well as daily games both inside and outside, crafts, music and other activities geared for children 6 to 9 years old. Campers should bring a sack lunch and beverage every day.

June 14 – Aug. 13      Hours: M – F 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Fee: \$100/resident a week; \$110/non-resident a week

### Camp Horizon

Ages: 9 – 13 years      Extended care hours are available.

Camp Horizon will be located at Indian Riffle School. Activities will include one field trip, swimming three times a week, as well as a variety of games including outdoor games in the woods, crafts and other activities geared for children 9 to 13 years old. Campers should bring a sack lunch and beverage every day.

June 14 – Aug. 6      Hours: M – F 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Fee: \$105/resident a week; \$115/non-resident a week

### Camp Sunsational

Ages: 8 – 12 years      Extended care hours are available.

Camp Sunsational will be located at Indian Riffle School.

Activities will include a wide variety of games, crafts and activities as well as swimming every afternoon (weather permitting). Campers should bring a sack lunch and beverage every day.

June 14 – Aug. 6      Hours: M – F 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

Fee: \$75/resident a week \$85/non-resident a week

### TOGA Camp — Teens On Go Adventures

Ages: 12 – 15 years

Teens On Go Adventure Camp will meet daily in the lobby of the Kettering Recreation Complex. From there, teens will travel to various locations to experience a wide variety of activities. We will visit parks, nature centers, educational sites, amusement parks, zoos and our own water park. Our goal is to keep active and on the go. Campers will swim on an average of three days a week. Fee for camp will include all admission costs and transportation. Campers need to bring a sack lunch each day.

June 14 – July 9      Hours: M – F 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Camp is limited to 13 campers.

Fee: \$135/resident a week \$145/non-resident a week

## EXTENDED CARE

Extended care hours are offered to participants in many of our summer camps. A special note is included in the description of each camp offering this option. This extended care is available from 7 to 9 a.m. and 3:30 to 6 p.m. each weekday at Rosewood Arts Centre, 2655 Olson Dr. If you use the extended care service, you will need to drop off and/or pick up your child at Rosewood. Your child will be escorted to and/or from the camp location. The fee for extended care service is \$40 per week or \$5 per session. The fee is payable to extended care staff at Rosewood on the first day of each week your child uses this service. For more information, call 296-2587.

**Residents: Monday, April 5 at 8 a.m. — Online Only!**

Residents can begin enrolling in camps online on Monday, April 5 at 8 a.m. Terminals are available at the Kettering Recreation Complex (KRC) and Rosewood Arts Centre (RAC) if patrons do not have a computer. Also, patrons who do not have a credit card may pay in advance by check at the KRC or RAC to have a balance placed in their household account to use online.



**Residents: Wednesday, April 7 at 8 a.m. — Online & Walk-In Only!**

Online registration continues for residents and walk-in registration begins at 8 a.m.

**Non-Residents: Monday, April 12 at 8 a.m. – Online & Walk-In Only!**

Non-residents can begin enrolling in camps online and in person on Monday, April 12 at 8 a.m. Terminals are available at the KRC and RAC if patrons do not have a computer. Also, patrons who do not have a credit card may pay in advance by check at the KRC or RAC to have a balance placed in their household account to use online.
