Investments to infrastructure on Braddock Street will continue over the next few years. The City of Kettering is coordinating with Montgomery County Environmental Services to ensure these investments are thoughtfully planned and successfully implemented. See below for more information:

Montgomery County Environmental Services (MCES) has contracted with Ford Development to replace water mains. The work is planned to start later this month, and is planned for completion this year. The MCES contact is David Swanson at 937-781-2695.

The City of Kettering is planning a roadway project in 2017, following the completion of the water main replacement project. For this project, the repair to the curb, sidewalk, and drive approaches will be assessed to the property owner. Additional details on the assessment process will be mailed to the property owners in early 2017. Upon completion of the concrete work, the asphalt pavement will be resurfaced.
